Follow these tips for best Scribing results!

Before the interaction


1. If using Scribe in a telephone clinic, make sure your patient is on speakerphone.
2. Make sure the mic or device (iPad / laptop / mobile) is placed near the patient and clinician.
3. Give brief verbal context at the beginning of clinical consults for the best results e.g. I am about to review Mr A, he is an 80 year old gentleman with a history of Type 2 Diabetes, he has a background of.....

During the interaction

1. Use clear, precise language: If the patient is hard to understand, confirm understanding by repeating key information back to the patient.
2. During the consultation, introduce yourself, the patient and anyone else present in the room e.g. Hello, I am Dr Smith, the Urologist, please confirm your name and date of birth. We also have Lucy Jones here, a clinical pharmacist.
3. Pause and resume encounters where appropriate
4. Vocalise your examination findings e.g. I am examining your chest and your heart sounds are normal, your heart rate is 60 and your pulse feels regular
5. Mention key negatives in your examination e.g. I can see that you have no nausea or photophobia
6. Recap names and doses of key medications
7. State clinical impressions explicitly
8. Summarise the plan out loud

After the interaction

1. Edit the note to ensure that you are happy with the output. Type, dictate or use the global smart "Add or adjust" button to make changes to your notes or patient letter e.g. My patient is neurodiverse, please write my letter in simple English that is easy to read or Please add a quote from the patient about their pain.
2. Create downstream documents from your generated note, including patient letters, Accurx SMS, discharge letters and more.



Elevate your Scribes

Dot phrases, located in Settings, allows you to add shortcuts to make clinical documentation even faster!

Press “,” to automatically insert pre loaded phrases into notes, such as when you’re discussing risk of a procedure.
