CURRICULA

— Voice Lesson

Working with me, you will learn to sing properly without strain, injury, or fatigue; receive feedback on musical interpretations; as well as gain the confidence necessary to maximize your true vocal potential! Studio space is available for prospective students across the performance experience spectrum who are interested in learning about and developing vocal techniques, foreign language diction, and song preparation skills. Further, you will learn techniques to augment your skills in reading music at sight. We will work together in order to strengthen foundation in rhythm and melody and the fundamentals of harmony. Finally you will develop the discipline necessary to practice between sessions for maximum results.

— Music Theory Lesson

As one of the fundamental building blocks of musical knowledge and understanding, music theory serves as one of our greatest assets to growth as a musician. We will work together to examine the elements that construct a piece of music, including **notation**, **key signatures**, **time signatures**, and **chord progressions**; explore **notes** and **scales** through **melodic** and **harmonic analyses**; and develop an understanding of **harmony** and **form** so as to strengthen your ability to read and perform music at sight. Whether you're a beginner with little knowledge or a pro looking to sharpen your skills, I'm here to meet you where you are and help you reach your goals!

TUITION

Lessons, coachings, and production sessions are offered in 30-, 45-, and 60-minute increments. 30-minute sessions may be booked at **\$65**; 45-minute sessions at **\$90**; and 60-minute sessions at a rate of **\$120 per session**. While 45-minute lessons are highly recommended for most students, we can uncover your specific needs during our initial consultation.

SCHEDULING A SESSION

All sessions begin with scheduling a free consultation on the Sinclair Music Studio booking page. After the initial consultation, you may use the same scheduling link to peruse available lesson dates and times. Generally, most students will keep the same day and time each week. In the event a student needs to change their lesson date and/or time, the student should send an email with their new preferred date/time (subject to availability). All available dates and times can be viewed through the scheduling link.

CANCELLATION POLICY

There is a **24-hour Cancellation Policy**. In the event that a voice lesson or coaching is cancelled within 24 hours of the scheduled time, the student is still responsible for 100% of the agreed upon rate for the lesson or coaching. If a lesson or coaching is cancelled outside of the 24-hour window, the lesson can be rescheduled at no cost, and at the instructor's convenience.

All students will receive one excused absence per quarter (Jan-Mar, e.g.) to cover unanticipated cancellation within 24 hours at no cost. These do not roll over. Instead, they reset at the beginning of each quarter.

Lessons and coachings cancelled by the instructor will be rescheduled at no additional cost.
