Our clients come from all walks of life, facing barriers such as financial hardship, career shifts, disabilities, and unexpected life changes. Through resume-building, skills training, advanced assessment tools, interview preparation, certifications and partnerships, **we help individuals not just find jobs, but build careers**.

THESE ARE REAL STORIES WITH REAL IMPACT

One client, previously unemployed and uncertain about their future, took a **certification course through our scholarship program**. That certification led to a full-time position with benefits—breaking the cycle of financial strain for their family.

Another client, struggling to pass employer assessments, utilized **Ed2Go practice courses and interview coaching**. Today, they hold a leadership role in their industry.

A client who transitioned industries saw their **hourly wage increase from \$17 to \$24 per hour**, a 30% boost in earnings– demonstrating the direct impact of skills training on financial stability.
