Application Form and Rules

About the bursary

The Michael Teys Strata Research and Development Bursary is an annual award of up to AUD \$10,000 funded by Michael Teys Strata Advisory. This bursary is designed to support and encourage academic research and learning in the field of strata management. The bursary aims to contribute to the development of specialised knowledge about strata management and the professionalisation of this important field.

Recipients may use the bursary funds for:

- tuition fees
- living expenses during study
- travel and conference expenses to present papers at relevant conferences.

Eligibility

Applications are open to:

- practicing strata managers
- students enrolled in relevant programs
- academics researching strata management or related fields
- applicants from Australia and overseas.

We particularly encourage applications from students and researchers in developing countries who are concerned with the development of higher density community living arrangements in their place of origin.



Application process

Application deadline: September 30 each year.

Required documentation:

- Completed application form (see below)
- Curriculum Vitae / Resume (maximum 2 pages)
- Academic transcript (if applicable)
- Research proposal or study plan (maximum 1,000 words)
- Two reference letters

Selection criteria:

Applications will be assessed based on:

- academic merit and / or professional achievement
- relevance and potential contribution to strata management knowledge
- clarity and feasibility of proposed research or study plan
- potential impact on the profession and/or developing countries.

Terms and conditions

The bursary of up to AUD \$10,000 will be awarded annually, subject to the receipt of sufficiently meritorious applications. The selection committee reserves the right not to award the bursary in any given year.

Recipients must provide a progress report within 12 months of receiving the bursary.

Any publications or presentations resulting from work supported by the bursary should acknowledge the support received from Michael Teys Strata Advisory.

The decision of the selection committee is final, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the outcome.

Successful applicants may be required to participate in promotional activities related to the bursary.
