We are pleased to share this data with the caveat that this data may be incomplete as it only reflects data collected for program purposes, and does not represent data from all clinics in a given area or population.

New Incentives - All Babies Are Equal (NI-ABAE) provides cash incentives to caregivers in northern Nigeria to increase childhood vaccination rates. When caregivers bring their infant in for routine immunizations, we provide a small cash incentive and information about the importance of vaccinations.

The All Babies program operates in government clinics in partnership with state and local governments and immunization partners.








Bauchi Retention Rate Q4 2022 & Q1 2023



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






