How to invite people to your party?



Decide on a day & time that works for the majority of people you are inviting.




Send out invitations to your friends & require them to RSVP in advance.



Create an invitation that includes brief details about the Watch Party and the date, time & venue.



Send reminders to your participants a couple of days before the event.

Part 2: Recognising Progress


- 1. Share: Your name, occupation & 1 thing you would like to master! (e.g. foreign languages, research skills, rock climbing and etc)
- 2. Discuss: Progress looks different for everyone. What does it mean to you?
- 3. What will you do to start recognising incremental progress in your own home/school/community? "I will ____" (e.g. I will start observing individual strengths and interests in the classroom)

To summarize the Watch Party experience & key discussion points


- 1.Get 2-3 individuals or groups to share a summary of their discussions or reflections
- 2. End the session by thanking the participants for their time






Venue with a computer, projector & internet




A computer with internet & video conferencing

- Bring your pillows & get cosy
- 4 Make sure it's quiet too!
