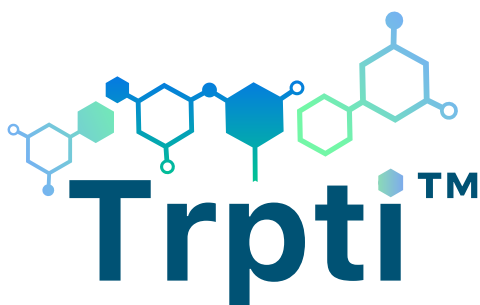

What is Trpti™?

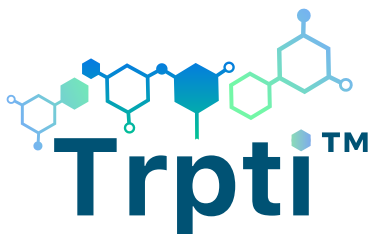

Clinical Data

Microbiome Study [300mg]

We found that Trpti™ acts successfully when administered orally (OEA with LipiSpense®) to bind to GPR-119 and produce GLP-1 naturally within the body.

Pilot Study with Crossover [300mg]

Food with Trpti™ (OEA with LipiSpense®) and food without OEA with a wash-off period.

This resulted in a significant GLP-1 increase, naturally produced in the body, when Trpti™ was taken with food.

Enogenous GLP-1 Study [150mg / 300mg]

Following the crossover study, we found that the 300mg Trpti™ (OEA with LipiSpense®) group saw:

- Significantly increased GLP-1 levels, up 25% compared to placebo
- Significantly reduced DPP-4 levels (the enzyme which degrades GLP-1 and obstructs it's activity) with partial recovery by 4 hours (~14%), enabling enhanced GLP-1 preservation
