SAFE HOUSE SUPPORT (\$201,000)

The safe house increased its monthly support to \$14,000/month, allowing the possibility to bring in 12 more girls (given enough staff). Additional needs were funded to:

- provide ELEVEN women with funds to start their own businesses
- send two young ladies to University and one for continuing education, while eight girls attend middle school and high school
- provide job training for FORTY-TWO women to secure their future independence
- take the girls & staff on a multi-day trip to Pokhara in April (the adventure of a lifetime)
- provide higher level dental care for multiple girls
- bring in TWENTY new girls!

Thank you for joining us in this journey to create a space where precious daughters come to be transformed, receiving healing, hope, and a future beyond their wildest dreams.

ADDITIONAL PROJECTS

Children's Homes – Funds were provided to a home for the children's education, as well as to help purchase a van to facilitate school runs more easily. Funds were also provided to Morning Star for those children's education.

Leper Colony – Supplemental nutrition was provided for over 200 residents of a leper colony (mixed beans & an egg a day), in addition to hosting a Christmas dinner.

Short-Term Missions Trips – A few teams made the long journey across the globe to participate in the Pokhara trip in April, a "stay-cation" in August, and graduation in November, bringing encouragement to our precious sisters.
