SAFE HOUSE SUPPORT (\$248,000)

The safe house maintained its monthly support at \$12,000/month. Additional needs were funded to:

- provide SEVEN women with funds to start their own businesses
- send two young ladies to University and one for continuing education, while eight girls attend middle school and high school
- provide job training for THIRTY-EIGHT women to secure their future independence
- take the girls on an overnight retreat to Dhulikhel in February
- rebuild a wall damaged by flash flooding
- purchase a bus to provide transportation for the growing safe home
- bring in TWENTY-SIX new girls!

ADDITIONAL PROJECTS

Children's Homes – Funds were provided to one home for the children's education, as well as to complete their roof and greenhouse at their new location. Funds were also provided to another home for those children's education.

Leper Colony – Through the generosity of a ministry partner, supplemental nutrition was provided for over 200 residents of a leper colony (mixed beans & an egg a day).

Short-Term Missions Trips – A few teams made the long journey across the globe to participate in graduations in February and November, as well as to bring encouragement to our precious sisters.
