

2021 ANNUAL REPORT

SAFE HOUSE SUPPORT (\$180,000)

The safe house maintained its monthly support at \$8000/month for the year. Additional needs totaling over \$84,000 were funded to:

- help TWO young ladies start their own businesses
- provide relief to graduates' families in need during another FIVE months of lockdowns
- send SIX young ladies on to higher education
- paid rent for the beauty parlor and tailoring shop during the lockdown
- cover medical bills for one volunteer injured in an accident ... and one staff hospitalized for pneumonia complications
- evacuate 12 residents during a safe house COVID outbreak (and bring them back)

FOUR new girls have come to the safe house in the past year, even in the midst of more lockdowns: one is attending school (along with seven others), two are in tailor training, and one is learning the beauty parlor business. To God be the glory!

ADDITIONAL PROJECTS

Children's Homes – Support for Peace Home was continued at \$1600/month, and a scholarship program was begun to support several students seeking advanced degrees.

Leper Colony – The safe house partners with a leper colony, providing new clothing from its tailor shop. Through the generosity of a ministry partner, supplemental nutrition was provided for over 200 residents (mixed beans & an egg a day).

Short-Term Missions Trips – A small team was finally able to visit the safe house in late November. These visits are vital to maintain relationships and encourage our brothers & sisters in ministry, especially after such a long time due to COVID.
