SAFE HOUSE SUPPORT (\$220,000)

The safe house increased its monthly support to \$12,000/month by the end of the year. Additional needs were funded to:

- provide TWO women with funds to start their own businesses
- send four young ladies on to higher education (while five younger girls attend elementary and middle school)
- provide job training for TWENTY-ONE women to secure their future independence
- cover medical bills for a few of the women
- provide education for children of a couple of the graduates
- continue furnishing the new safe house (opened in June)
- bring in NINETEEN new girls (doubled from last year)!

ADDITIONAL PROJECTS

Children's Homes – As one home relocated to India, funds were provided to help with moving costs and the first six months on their self-sustaining acreage.

Leper Colony – Through the generosity of a ministry partner, supplemental nutrition was provided for over 200 residents of a leper colony (mixed beans & an egg a day).

Short-Term Missions Trips – Several small teams made the long journey across the globe to deliver funding for the building project, as well as to bring encouragement to our precious sisters. A larger team was able to take the girls out of the city for a retreat that affirmed their God-given worth.
