

2022 ANNUAL REPORT

SAFE HOUSE SUPPORT (\$181,000)

The safe house increased its monthly support to \$8200/month for the year. Additional needs totaling over \$84,000 were funded to:

- provide FOUR women with supplemental help for their businesses
- send four young ladies on to higher education (while six younger girls attend elementary and middle school)
- provide job training for EIGHT women to secure their future independence
- cover medical bills for a few of the girls who had various surgeries & dental work
- purchase a scooter to transport staff to local markets & to take girls to appointments
- bring in TEN new girls!

In addition to the above funding, a beautiful new building is in the works. This has been fully funded & furnished by a generous partner and represents many years of prayer, countless months of searching for suitable land, and many weeks of nearly round-the-clock supervision and labor. To God be the glory!

ADDITIONAL PROJECTS

Children's Homes – Support for Peace Home was continued at \$1600/month, and additional emergency funds were provided for a home which cares for children with HIV.

Leper Colony – Through the generosity of a ministry partner, supplemental nutrition was provided for over 200 residents of a leper colony (mixed beans & an egg a day).

Short-Term Missions Trips – Several small teams made the long journey across the globe to deliver funding for the building project, as well as to bring encouragement to our precious sisters. A larger team was able to take the girls out of the city for a retreat that affirmed their God-given worth.
