

Guide to e-learning for healthcare

Introduction

We are currently using e-learning for healthcare (eLfH) for most of our mandatory training whilst we establish a new learning platform. The following guide will take you through the steps to find the relevant courses which are listed in the table below.

Information Governance (Data protection)	60 mins	Annually
Level 1 Safeguarding Adults	40 mins	Once
Level 2 Safeguarding Adults	40 mins	Every 2 years
Level 1 Safeguarding Children and Young People	30 mins	Once
Level 2 Safeguarding Children and Young People	35 mins	Every 2 years
Level 3 Safeguarding Children and Young People (child weight management and stop smoking only)	30 mins	Every 2 years
Moving and handling – level 1	40 mins	Every 2 years
Health, safety and welfare – level 1	35 mins	Every 2 years
Fire safety – level 1	30 mins	Every 2 years
Equality, diversity and human rights – level 1	30 mins	Every 2 years

Finding Courses

Step 1:

Log into your eLfH account


Step 2:

Use the search bar (see below) at the top of the screen to search your first course.



Step 3:

Type in a course such as "moving and handling" into the search bar and click on the magnifying glass icon (circled red above). A list of courses is provided similar to the one illustrated below:




Scroll down the page until you find: Moving and Handling – level 1 with a PLAY icon at the side.





Step 4:

Select PLAY and a pop-up window will appear launching the course.




Step 5:

Repeat steps 2-4 for each of the listed mandatory training modules. If you have already completed level 1 safeguarding in our previous platform Litmos, you do not need to repeat it here, move onto safeguarding level 2.

Step 1: Search "Safeguarding Children" and a folder called Safeguarding Children and Young People (SGC) will be listed.



Click on this folder and all three levels of safeguarding children and young people will be shown.







Search "safeguarding adults" and a folder called Safeguarding Adults (SGA) will appear.



Click on this folder and all safeguarding adults' modules will show. You only need to complete levels 1 & 2. When you click on a course it will take you to another page, where the PLAY icon will display.
