What topics are covered?

The workshop highlights the power of **collaboration**, **iterative development**, and **self-organization** by exploring the **Scrum framework** through interactive **LEGO**-based exercises.

01 - Scrum Simulation

Participants experience the full **Scrum** cycle-including **planning**, **execution**, **sprint review**, and **retrospective**-using LEGO bricks to build creative solutions.

02 - Continuous Collaboration

The workshop emphasizes the importance of daily collaboration, **simulating an Agile work environment** where **managers** and **developers** must interact constantly to **effectively meet project needs.**

03 - Adaptation and Feedback

Participants learn to **respond to changing requirements**—even in late stages of a project—by practicing **quick iterations** and receiving **immediate feedback** during simulated sprints.



OBJECTIVES_

Why attend a workshop on the Agile methodology?

An Agile workshop is essential for directly learning **strategies** that **optimize the management** of modern and complex projects.

Through **hands-on exercises**, participants learn how to improve **collaboration** between **team** members and other **stakeholders**, **adapt** quickly to changes, and **increase productivity** through short work cycles and continuous feedback.

The Agile approach puts the **customer at the center**, ensuring the final product meets—and exceeds—expectations while fostering a work environment that **encourages innovation**.

The workshop provides not only **technical skills** but also an agile mindset that can transform the approach to work and boost **organizational efficiency**.





IN PRACTICE_

How does the workshop work?

The workshop is divided into two parts. First, an **overview of Scrum** is presented, with a focus on its benefits and pitfalls. Then, participants are **split into groups and asked to actively build something** using LEGO bricks, **applying Scrum principles**.
