





Tax Postponements Announced in October 2024

The IRS announced tax deadline relief due to Hurricane Milton in most of Florida. Most tax-related deadlines falling on or after October 5, 2024, and before May 1, 2025, are now due May 1, 2025.

Combined with earlier tax relief provided for taxpayers in counties affected by <u>Hurricane Debby</u> and <u>Hurricane Helene</u>, affected taxpayers in all of Florida now have until May 1, 2025, to file various federal individual and business tax returns and make tax payments, including 2024 individual and business returns normally due during March and April 2025 and 2023 individual and corporate returns with valid extensions and quarterly estimated tax payments.

The <u>IRS announced tax deadline relief</u> in the city and county of Juneau in Alaska. Most tax-related deadlines falling on or after August 5, 2024, and before May 1, 2025, are now due May 1, 2025.
