Re: Dr Aseem Malhotra, GMC number 6029224

Please find attached below our previous letters to you in support of Dr Malhotra. We understand there are renewed complaints against him, from the same doctors who complained previously. We are deeply concerned that this constitutes a witch hunt against Dr Malhotra.

Dr Malhotra, when speaking at the Reform Party conference, made what was certainly a controversial remark quoting oncologist Professor Dalgleish as saying, "It is highly likely that the covid vaccines have been a significant factor in the cancers of members of the Royal Family".

As far as we are aware, neither Dr Malhotra nor Professor Dalgleish attends the Royal family and thus the remarks were certainly not a breach of patient confidentiality. Both doctors initially recommended Covid-19 vaccines but changed their stance after seeing patient harms post-vaccination. Since then they have followed the GMC's <u>Good Medical Practice</u> guidance to "Act promptly if you think that patient safety or dignity may be seriously compromised."

In a <u>BMJ News</u> item, the same doctors who originally filed a complaint against Dr Malhotra claim that the GMC failed in its investigations. The article also quotes the Health Secretary stating that Dr Malhotra's Reform speech contained "*poisonous lies*" and the Shadow Health Secretary saying the claim of a link between Covid vaccination and cancer in the Royal Family was "*baseless*" and "*dangerous disinformation*".

However, the BMJ article failed to acknowledge or address the accumulating body of evidence supporting an oncogenic effect from repeated mRNA covid-19 injections. Several studies have shown a steep increase in cancers since 2021, especially in <u>young adults</u>, including in England & Wales a 59% rise in cancers of <u>unknown primary site</u>. A peer-reviewed study from <u>Japan</u> found a higher risk in several different cancers after the national rollout of the third dose but was retracted

by the editors two months later with no explanation. Most governments have failed to release the linked vaccination data which could determine once and for all whether the vaccines are or are not a causative factor, but linked data from South Korea has shown a <u>significant rise in multiple cancers</u> comparing vaccinated to the unvaccinated. Another <u>single centre study</u> showed reduced survival times in pancreatic cancer patients who had received multiple doses of covid vaccines and this correlated with raised levels of IgG4. As for plausibility, the many possible mechanisms are reviewed <u>here</u>. Significant DNA contamination, from the manufacturing method used for the mass rollout, has been <u>confirmed</u> by multiple researchers, with unknown consequences for health.

We quote the above papers not to provide a definitive answer, but as examples to illustrate the evolving picture and plausible link between the covid vaccines and increased risk of cancer. Blanket statements that there is no evidence that the vaccines cause cancer are no longer tenable.

As stated in our previous letters, from everything we have witnessed in our clinical practice or read in the published literature over the last five years, we believe that Dr Malhotra has acted highly responsibly, in line with his ethical duties as a doctor, in calling for a suspension of the use of Covid vaccines pending the results of a full and independent safety analysis.

Censuring Dr Malhotra would have a chilling effect on potential whistleblowers, which is highly detrimental to patient safety. In a BMA survey last year, 61% of those polled said they may not raise concerns because they were "afraid" they or colleagues could be "unfairly blamed or suffer adverse consequences". We would remind you of your statement in previous correspondence, "It is vital that healthcare has a culture that encourages and supports speaking up about patient safety concerns. This is why we continue to encourage doctors to speak up if they have any concerns, or if they are concerned that they may have experienced a retaliatory or threatening referral."

Far from bringing the profession into disrepute, large sections of the public have expressed gratitude to Dr Malhotra for having the courage to speak out. This sort of <u>transparency</u>, even for negative outcomes, is vital for maintaining the public's trust in medical professionals. Dr Malhotra's views are demonstrably not 'baseless'. He is one of an ever-increasing minority of doctors alarmed by the failure of the regulators worldwide to withdraw these products in the face of clear evidence of serious harm. See for example, the <u>Hope Accord</u>. Calling his fitness to practice into question will be detrimental to patient safety, silencing other ethical doctors wishing to report concerns about the covid vaccines.

We urge you to reject yet another vexatious complaint against Dr Malhotra, which appears to be politically motivated. We request that this letter and all our previous letters and the October 2023 Statement of Support be shared with the GMC investigators, as evidence for their consideration.
