// Anchor Chapters: Judges 6-7

1.) Gideon was threshing wheat in hiding because he was intimidated & afraid of the enemies of God's people.

//Judges 6:11

2.) God knew where Gideon was & called him up as a mighty man of valor (**Judges 6:12**), assuring Gideon of His presence (**Judges 6:16**) and power. (**Judges 6:34**)

3.) Gideon & every man obediently & boldly stood in their place relying on God!

//Judges 7:21

How does this point to Jesus?

The "foolishness" of Gideon's army - being reduced to a humble number but still rescuing God's people from an army of so many - reminds us of the "foolishness" of the message of the cross (to the world); but, the message of the cross is the Power of God to those of us being saved!
