// Anchor Verse: Judges 13:5

- 1.) Samson was set apart for God’s purposes and was used powerfully when the Spirit of the Lord would come on him.

//Judges 13:24-25; 14:6; 19; 15:14

- 2.) Although Samson made mistakes and seemed to be a slave to his own fleshly desires, whenever Samson would call out to God, God would listen to him and powerfully answer his prayers as a man of faith.

//Judges 15:18-19; 16:28; Hebrews 11:32-34

- 3.) Be encouraged to know that although there were many “successes” and “failures” throughout Samson’s life, in the end, he fulfilled the purposes that God had planned for his life.

//Judges 16:30

How this points to Christ:

Both Samson and Jesus were dedicated to God for a specific saving mission. They were betrayed by those closely associated with them for money. Both die with arms out stretched. Samson’s arms stretched out against the pillars of a pagan temple. Christ’s arms were out stretched on the cross where he defeated the power of sin and death.
