

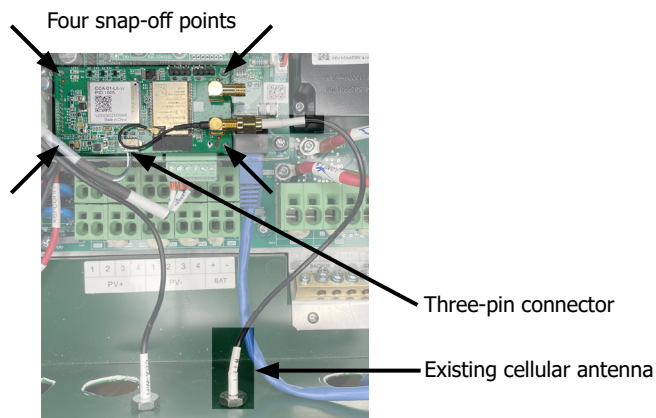
The GO Cellular Kit network adapter lets a Tigo CCA connect to cellular networks. The CCA gateway/data logger is an integral part of all GO ESS solutions.



- Turn off all sources of power to the GO Inverter and wait until no LEDs are lit before installing the GO Cellular Kit.

GO ESS (US) – Remove Existing Cellular Network Card and Antenna

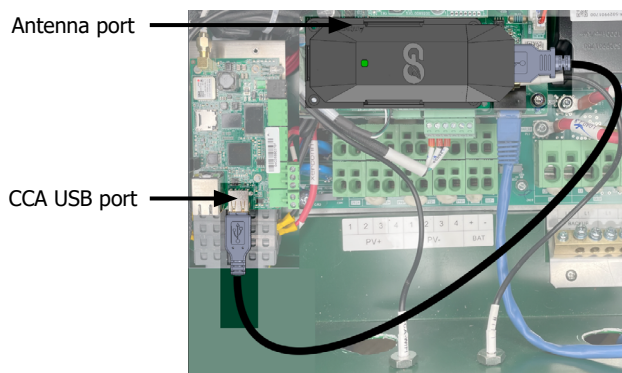
1. Turn off all sources of power to the inverter:
 - The inverter DC disconnect
 - The battery breaker/DC disconnect
 - The ATS *Service disconnect* or inverter breakers within the ATS
 Wait until no LEDs appear lit.
2. Snap-off the cellular antenna board.
Disconnect and disregard the three-pin connector.



3. Remove the cellular antenna.

GO ESS (US) – Install and Connect the Adapter and Antenna

1. Snap the adapter bracket onto the four white support pins and attach the adapter.
2. Plug the adapter cable into the CCA USB port.

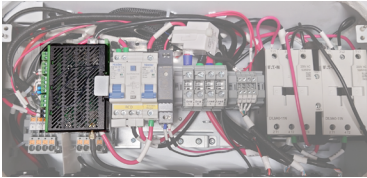


3. Replace the cellular antenna assembly and plug it into the adapter Antenna port.

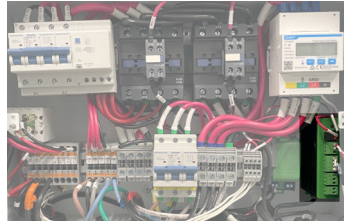
GO ESS (EU) – Install and Connect the Adapter

1. Turn off the GO Link *DC Switch*.
Wait until no LEDs appear lit.
2. In the GO Link, locate the CCA component.

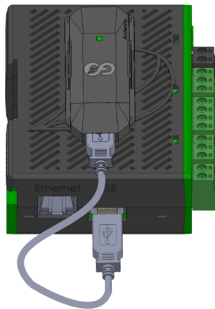
Single-phase EI Link

3. Snap the adapter bracket onto the CCA and attach the adapter.
If there is not enough clearance, tuck the adapter into a convenient space.
4. Plug the USB cable into the CCA USB port.

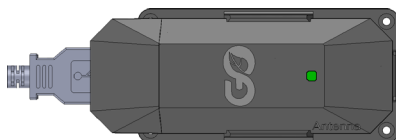


GO ESS (EU) – Install and Connect the Antenna

1. Install the antenna in one of the holes on the left side of the EI Link.
2. Plug the adapter cable into the CCA USB port.



2. Route the antenna cable through an open port at the bottom of the EI Link and connect it to the adapter *Antenna* port.
