

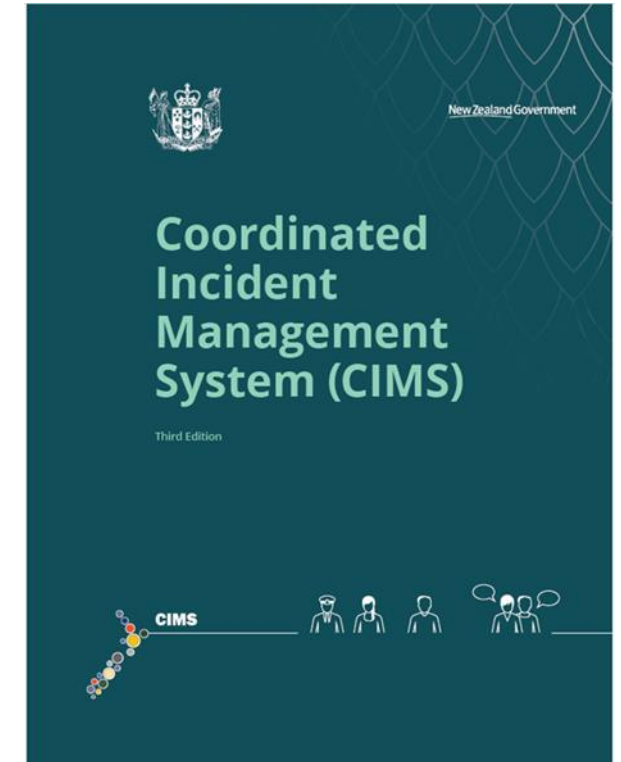

Māori Emergency Management Network

Background (National)

- 2017: Ministerial reviews National EM system
- 2018 Government agrees to **recognize** the role of Iwi Māori in EM
- 2019: CIMS framework amended to include **references** to Iwi/Māori
- 2023: Report of the Government Inquiry into the Response to the North Island Severe Weather Events (Mateparae Report)
 - Put people and their communities at the heart of the emergency management system
 - Recognise the role of iwi Māori throughout the system



“Events on this scale need leaders [...] We have a responsibility to look after our people and those that live among us in an emergency. We should be given the authority to do so. Gisborne Civil Defence and District Council don’t have the resources or outreach to provide sufficient support to the Coast.”

Background (International)

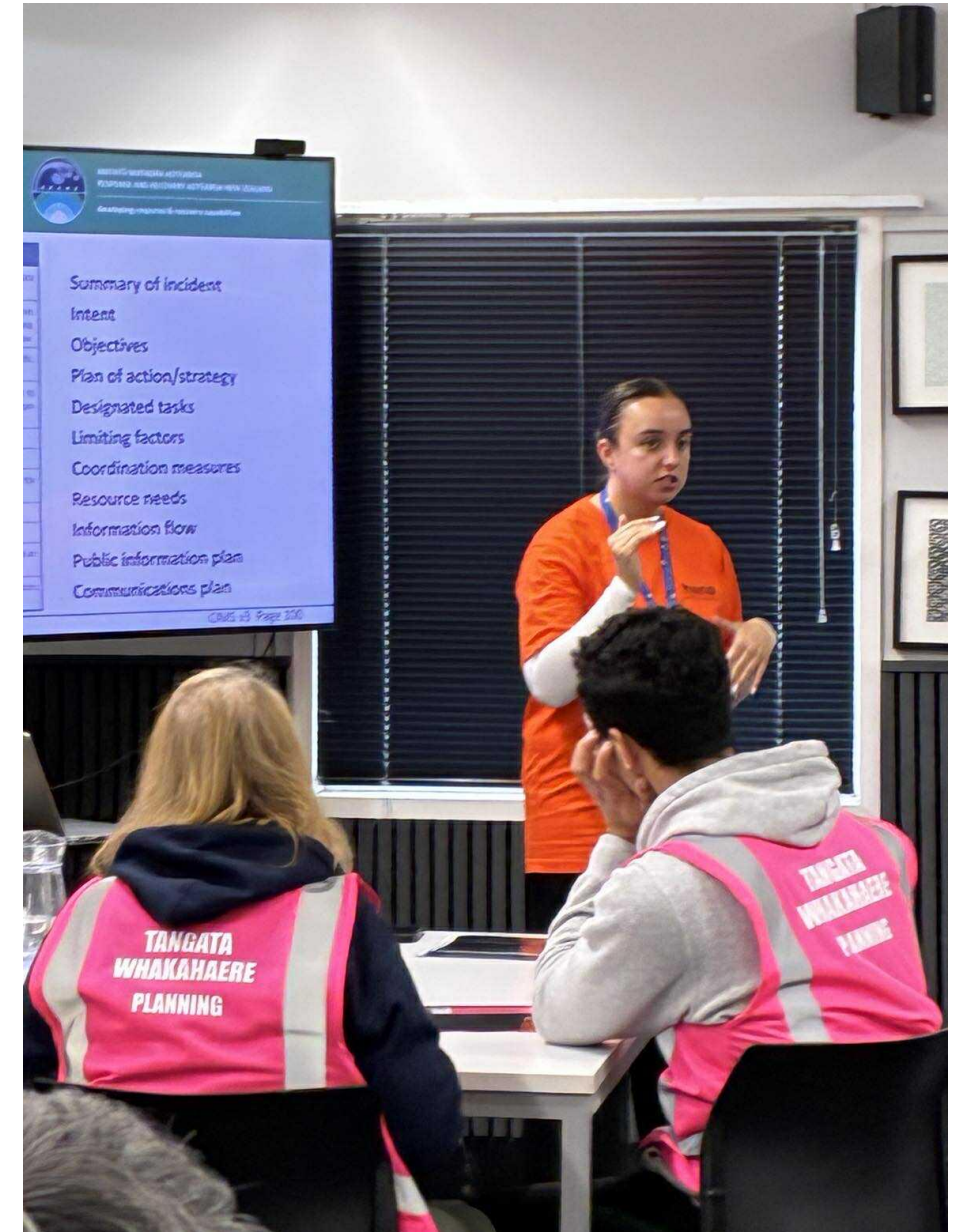

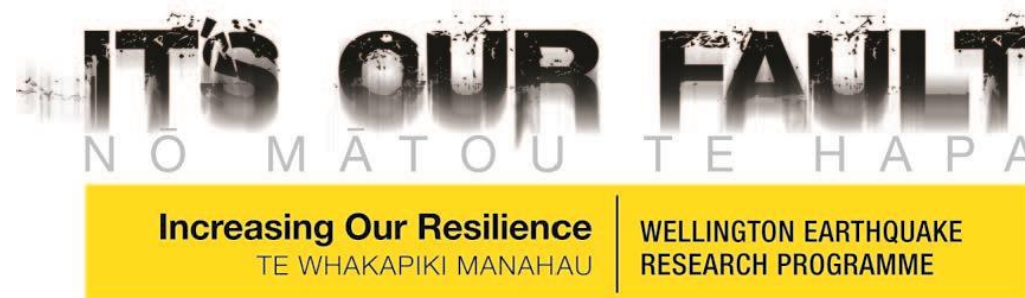
