Wildfire prevention & recovery

Wildfire prevention and recovery has been at the forefront of many Lincoln County residents' minds in recent years. Our Wildfire Preparedness Technician Matthew Rosman has provided more than 50 landowners with home hardening assessments and distributed over \$43,000 in cost share toward fuel reduction projects.

Dreger Farms irrigation project

The Dreger Farms irrigation project, replacing 2.3 miles of leaking mainline and a 1,325-foot pivot system, was the largest cost share project the District has funded to date. This project saved an estimated 360,000 gallons of water a month by replacing the failing older structure.

Other accomplishments



Completed our third Department of Ecology Direct Seed grant, assisting in the adoption of no-till on over 3,000 acres.



We performed 280 Conservation Reserve Program field status review checks between Lincoln and Adams counties in partnership with National Resources Conservation Service.



Planted 3,600 plants in a mixed riparian and upland site for a producer enrolled in the Environmental Quality Incentives Program.
