Dear Bonneville County Board of Commissioners,

After reviewing the written proposals, cost information, technical requirements, cloud services responses, implementation approach, and overall alignment with the County's needs, the evaluation committee recommends that Bonneville County proceed with **Aumentum Technologies** as the highest-ranked proposer for RFP 2601.

The recommendation is based on the County's evaluation criteria and the committee's determination of best overall fit. Although both vendors presented credible solutions, Aumentum's response demonstrated several factors that were especially important to the County.

Aumentum demonstrated substantial experience with Idaho property tax and appraisal procedures. This includes a long-standing relationship with other Idaho counties and familiarity with Idaho-specific statutory requirements, tax processes, exemptions, credits, levy structures, Tax Commission reporting, and county workflows.

Aumentum's existing presence in Idaho and experience with similar county environments were viewed as factors in reducing implementation risk. Given the complexity of Bonneville County's current property tax, CAMA, GIS, Treasurer, Auditor, Assessor, and IT workflows, the committee placed high value on Idaho experience and the ability to support a transition without placing the County in the position of serving as an early test case for Idaho functionality.

The committee also considered Aumentum's current technology environment. Aumentum presented a true SaaS solution that supports the County's goal of reducing on-premise infrastructure, improving security, simplifying long-term maintenance, and providing a more sustainable platform for future updates and legislative changes. Catalis, while providing SaaS infrastructure, still requires the use of a virtual desktop in AWS Appstream for connection to the CAMA solution. Aumentum also offers SSO on the full platform, while Catalis has roadmapped SSO for its CAMA offering at an unspecified date. The ability to have a dedicated mobile field environment also added value to Aumentum's proposal.

Aumentum's proposal also showed a strong understanding of Bonneville County's existing environment and the need to move from fragmented, legacy, state-hosted processes

toward a more integrated and sustainable platform. The proposed approach aligns with the County's goals of improving data integrity, reducing manual processes, supporting long-term legislative adaptability, and modernizing assessment and property tax operations.

Cost was carefully considered. Catalis submitted a more favorable cost proposal and that was recognized by the committee. However, after weighing cost against Idaho-specific experience, implementation risk, statutory complexity, SaaS readiness, and long-term operational continuity, the committee determined that Aumentum represented the best overall value for Bonneville County under the published evaluation criteria.

In consideration of the above, the evaluation committee recommends that the Board of Commissioners award RFP 2601 to **Aumentum Technologies**.
