
What is Safeguarding in the BHA

- The BHA is committed to ensuring the welfare of Young Persons and Adults at Risk within racing. The BHA expects all Persons to share this commitment and maintain appropriate standards and behaviour in their dealings with Young Persons and Adults at Risk.

- Reliance on the industry to work with the BHA
