

Maccabiah Photo Finish Highlights

Framing this unit

Participants use primary sources to curate a visual story to reflect on their Jewish identity. Through discussion, they will consider if and how sports shape their Jewish identity and their connection to Israel.

Creative activity

- Select and cut out 3–4 primary sources from the [Maccabiah Photo Finish Highlights sheet](#). While choosing, think about (1) the historical significance of the primary source, (2) your personal connection to it, and (3) how it relates to your connection to Israel.
- Arrange and glue the primary sources on a sheet of paper in a linear sequence that tells a meaningful story.
- Write a caption below each primary source describing what it represents, and give the sequence a title that reflects the story you are telling.
- Present your story to the group

Discussion Questions

- Are there primary sources interpreted differently by multiple participants?
- If you could add another primary source to your visual story that represents what you hope for Israel's future, what would it be?
