

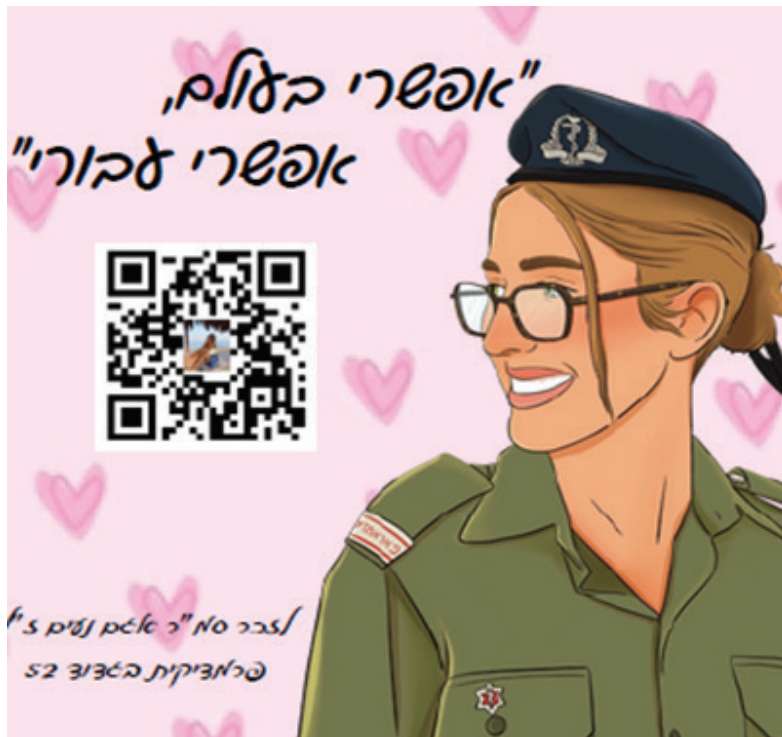
Staff Sergeant Agam Naim z"l
