

## Hebrew Dominoes - Instructions

Thanks to Eliezer Ben-Yehuda's efforts, Hebrew is a remarkable example of a successful language revival of an ancient, nearly extinct language into a vibrant, fully functional modern language used in prayer and spoken by millions today.

But Hebrew words can sometimes be tricky! Some Hebrew words sound the same but have different meanings (**homophones**), and some are spelled the same but have multiple meanings (**homographs**).

1. Cut out each set of dominoes and shuffle them. Each color is a separate domino set.
2. Decide which set you want to start with and divide the domino cards between the players in the group.
3. Each player, in turn, adds one domino card to the board to correctly match a Hebrew to its correct English translation. If a player cannot play a domino card, they miss a turn.

**Homophones** – match the Hebrew word with its correct English translation.

**Homographs** – match the Hebrew word with its correct English translation.
