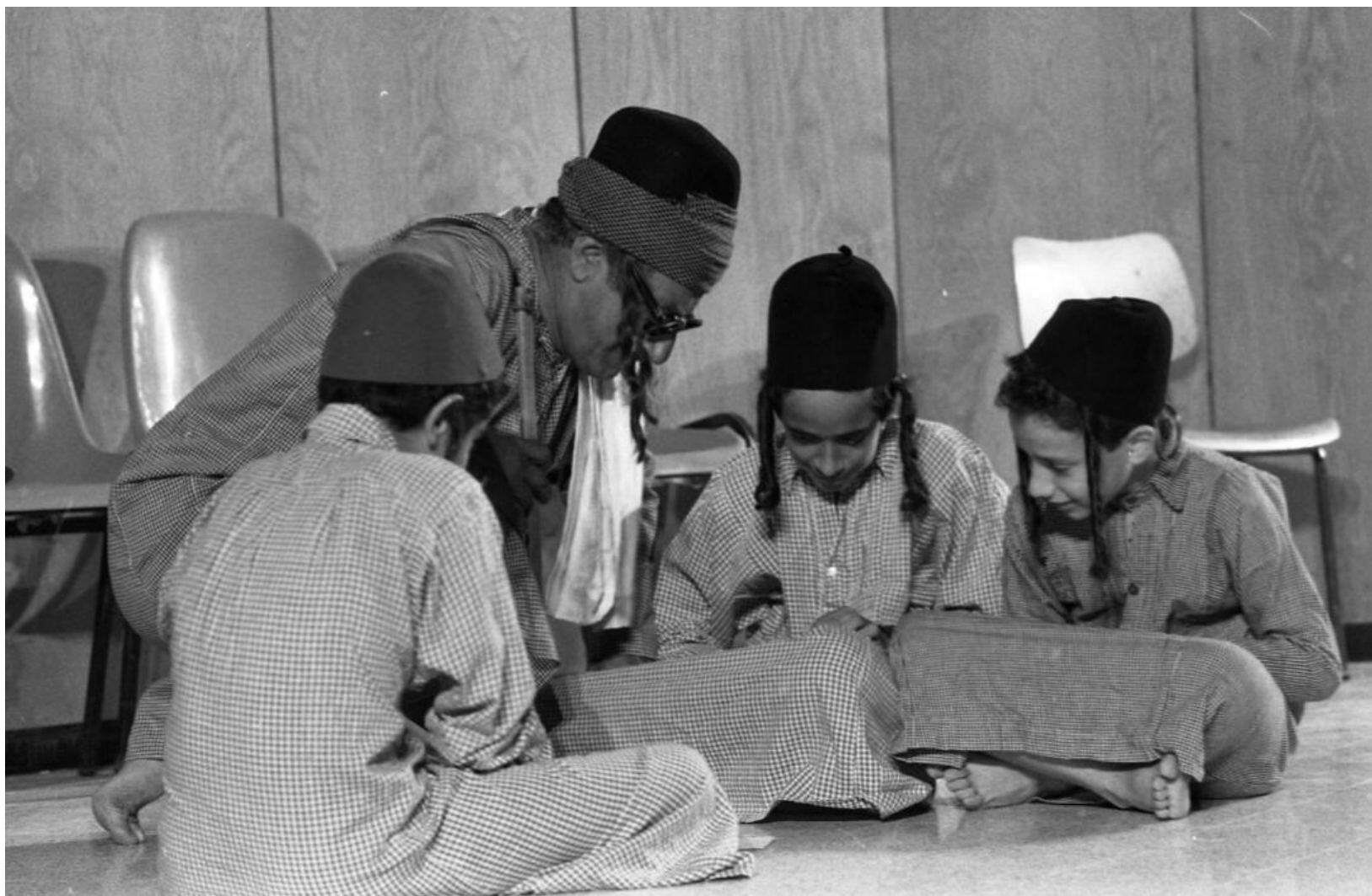


Yemenite Traditions: Reading Hebrew
