Troubleshoot computers and network, configure hardware and software, ensure staff back-ups in place, processes are up-to-date and timely computer upgrades or replacements.
SERVER ADMINISTRATION - INSTALL, UPDATE, & UPGRADE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Responsible for installing new systems and assessing and implementing upgrades as needed. Conduct consistent analyses of Investment Fiji's computer systems to determine if existing components meet Investment Fiji's need and perform upgrades or updates as needed. This includes all servers and hosts.
MANAGE NETWORK SECURITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assess security programs and consult the Head of IT to choose the best for Investment Fiji for which they are employed. Install and manage these systems, conduct updates, create passwords and run checks for viruses and spyware. Use server and network monitoring tools to ensure all services are up and running. Ensure Antivirus is up to date and minimize all risks to the network. Other related tasks may also be given by the Head of IT.
SERVER & DATA BACKUP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure all servers and services are backed up and a copy is stored at a remote site for contingency planning. This should include incremental and full backups of the entire infrastructure.
PABX MANAGEMENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Responsible for ensuring that the telephone system is working correctly with scheduled backups in place. All system administration to be managed by the IT Administrator
PROJECTS & NEW IMPLEMENTATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The IT Administrator will come up with suggestions to improve the network and server platform, with new technologies and upgrades in place. The IT Administrator to assist the Head of IT for all research and implementation for infrastructure projects.
