1). School age students (ages 6 – 9):

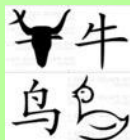
Lessons are Chinese language and culture related. All levels are welcome! In addition to Chinese reading and writing, children will have fun everyday with our exciting activities such as stories, arts and crafts, games, music, songs, and parties. Our goal is not just learning Chinese, but to make learning Chinese enjoyable! Math lessons are also provided daily.

- ❖ Only **full-day** summer camp is offered to this age group. Half-day option is not available.
- ❖ **Music and Art** lessons taught by specialty teachers are offered at additional \$27/week each.

2). Preschoolers (ages 2 - 5):

Children at this age are especially gifted with sensitive hearing and the ability to imitate, making it the ideal time to pick up a language! This fun program is filled with songs, stories, games, play, friends, and lots of laughter. Performing arts and crafts are integrated into daily activities. **Full-day** summer camp provides a Chinese-English bilingual environment – children will naturally absorb both languages and impress you with their amazing language skills! This program also lays a strong academic foundation to prepare older students for kindergarten. Math lessons are provided daily. **Morning** summer camp focuses on Chinese immersion—since it's a shorter time frame, no English or math lessons will be taught. Whether attending the full-day or half-day summer camp, there is no need for a prior Chinese language background. Teachers will assist with any necessary translations to help newer children understand the lessons.

- ❖ Both **full-day** and **half-day** options are available.
- ❖ **Music, Art, and Tumble Bus** taught by specialty teachers are for full-day camp only. Each is additional \$27/week.
- ❖ Since it takes longer for younger children to overcome separation anxiety, the minimum attendance is 4 consecutive weeks for children of age 2.

## Breakfast, Lunch and Snacks for Full-day Camp (全日制暑期班早餐、午餐、和小吃) -

- Nutritious lunch is served at noon. Each meal contains meat, dairy, grain, and vegetables/fruits. Menu is posted in school. Students are welcome to bring their own food. Tuition is the same.
- Snacks are served in the mid-morning and mid-afternoon.
- Cereal, waffle and milk are available before 8 am upon request.
- Our camp is peanut free. For other allergies, intolerance, preference, or religious concerns, parents are responsible to bring their own food for their children. We are unable to provide substitute food. Tuition is the same, whether the child eats school food or not.

## Fees and Policies (学费及规则) –

- Space is reserved only with full payment.
- \$50 non-refundable processing fee per payment per child. This fee can't be combined with any other programs.  
*Example-1: if you paid for 9:00-5:00 but later want to add 5:45pm after-camp care, you will be charged for the 5:45pm after-camp care fee plus \$50.*  
*Example-2: if you paid for week-1 but later want to add week-2, you will need to pay this \$50 processing fee again.*
- Advanced students may join older students' class, but it doesn't change the tuition rate. The tuition rate is strictly based on the student's own age.
- 15% tuition discount for week-0 and week-2 due to Juneteen and Independence Day (no school on 6/19 & 7/3).
- The 10th week is FREE, if tuition has been paid for 9 full weeks. This free offer doesn't apply to before / after camp care or other services.
- There is no refund, credit, makeup days, time switch, or any kind of fee adjustment under any circumstances after tuition is paid, regardless of when it is paid, including but not limited to students' sick leave and quarantine period, regardless of whether the contact happened in school or elsewhere. Please read the health policy on the next page.
- Late pickup fee is \$10 per 1-15 minutes, due on the spot. There is an additional \$1 per calendar day for late payment.
- The fees below are for summer-only students. Our preschool students stay with their regular fee schedule.

### Step 1 – Email us the registration form

We will email you the fee calculation accordingly.

### Step 2 – Pay tuition online via Zelle

After receiving our fee calculation, please pay online via Zelle:

- One transaction per child. Please don't mix different children in one transaction.

## Important Notes (重要注意事项):

1. Your child is not registered until we receive the full payment.
2. Space is limited and on a first come, first serve basis.
3. **Health policy** - Students can't come to school if they are sick or need isolation / quarantine recommended by CDC guidelines. They may return to the program when at least 24 hours have passed since recovery – defined as no fever without the use of medications and improvement in respiratory signs like cough and shortness of breath. There is no tuition refund, credit, time switch, or any kind of fee and/or attending schedule adjustment for sick leaves and quarantine days, regardless of whether the contact occurred at school or elsewhere.
  - a. **Return to school after recovering from COVID** – wear a well-fitted mask until day 10.
  - b. **Close contacts of COVID** (defined as within 6 ft with a positive case for 15 minutes or longer in 24 hours) - wear a well-fit mask in school until day 5.
