2025-2026 TUITION/FEE SCHEDULE

The new Tuition and Fee Schedule was sent to your email inbox last week. The schedule is also available on the school website at aberdeenroncalli.org/admissions/tuition.

After a great deal of discussion and review, there were some changes made to tuition and to the fee structure. The changes were necessary and we feel will be an advantage to all our families.

2025-2026 ENROLLMENT

All returning students have been rolled over into 25-26 enrollment. Each student's tuition contract has been generated. Please go into your Finalsite Parent Portal to sign the tuition contracts, and update a few items on your student(s) enrollment checklist. We ask that you sign your tuition contract by August 1.

******Chromebook forms:** 6-12 grade families will sign the Chromebook Insurance form on Finalsite this year. The fee has been added into the new fee breakdown so no payment will be collected at the time of signing that insurance form.

OPENING DAY OF SCHOOL

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 20, 2025

Kindergarten students will start the first two days of school on a split schedule. Families will receive a letter stating which day their student should attend.

All other students are to report at the regular start time for a full day of classes.

BRIDGING THE GAP

The actual cost of an education per child at ACSS is \$9,800. We invite you to consider providing additional support to the school by paying the full tuition rate or a different donated amount to bridge the gap between full tuition and the tuition rate we put forth. This amount can be billed along with your tuition according to your chosen payment plan

**SCHOOL MEALS**

The Aberdeen Catholic School System (ACSS) serves nutritious meals each day classes are in session for PreK-12th grade. The cost of the school meals are listed to the left.

The following Lunch Policy will be enforced.

If a student's lunch account is overdrawn by \$15 or more, the student will be allowed to purchase a reimbursable meal, BUT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to purchase extra entrée, milk or al a carte item until the account is paid.

If a student's account is overdrawn by \$100, that student will be informed and will be required to bring a sack lunch until the account is paid. Parents will be notified of an overdue amount via email and then by letter.

**MYSCHOOLBUCKS.COM**

We are asking all families to sign up for a MySchoolBucks account. This will help you maintain, monitor and make payments on your child's school meal account!!!

You will not be required to make payments on the website, but you will have total access to a record of your students spending and eating habits. You can make payments on your account at any of the school sites or on the myschoolbucks website.

There are also two phone apps you may consider downloading. MYSCHOOLBUCKS and MY SCHOOL MENUS. You can find these free apps in the App Store. Your child's balance and lunch menus will be at your fingertips. The app will also alert you when your child reaches a low balance (you can set the amount). Using the website or phone app will give you access to your student's activity and balance any time of the day or night!!!

REFER A FRIEND 'BONUS'

6TH GRADE & TRANSFER STUDENTS IMMUNIZATION

South Dakota Department of Health administrative rules require both the Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) and MCV4 (Meningococcal ACYW) vaccines for 6th grade students. The requirements apply only for 6th grade entry and transfer students in 6th–12th grade.

If a child is 10 years old when entering the 6th grade, they have 45 days after their 11th birthday to be vaccinated. Reference the links below to get more details and answer questions.
