The Village of East Aurora provides a comprehensive solid waste program designed to encourage recycling and waste reduction, reduce litter in our neighborhoods and ensure that waste is disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner.

We at WM look forward to helping your community be as clean - and green as possible.

Trash

Trash is collected weekly and limited to the contents of the 96g WM cart. Lids must be firmly closed. Please place carts at the curb by 6:00 am the day of your scheduled service. See attached listing for service day.

Recycling

Recycling is collected every other week, and limited to the contents of the 96g WM cart. Lids must be firmly closed. Please place carts at the curb by 6:00 am the day of your scheduled service. See attached listing for service day.

All recycling must be placed loose in your cart for collection. Do not bag your recyclables. Please refer to the attached listing of items that are acceptable in this curbside collection program.

BRUSH COLLECTION April 7-October 14

Brush Chipping Only, no yard waste pick-up is done curbside. Collection at the beginning of each week.

LEAF COLLECTION October 15-December 5 (weather permitting)

Leaf Collection will begin on October 15th and continue through December 5th, weather permitting.

(Should snow begin prior to 12/5, collection will end early).

* Leaves should be raked and piled at the curb, not in the street.

* Bagged leaves or leaves in containers will not be picked up.

Bulky and White Goods Collections

Bulk and White Goods items will be collected on your regular trash day during the third full week of each month.

Bulk Waste means large household items that do not properly fit in the Cart. Such materials include but are not limited to furniture, area and floor rugs, shelving, lamps, outdoor furniture, (mattresses, box springs, headboards would be considered one item), desks, tables, etc.

White Goods are defined as household appliances such as refrigerators or stoves.

WM shall collect up to three (3) Bulky items and/or White Goods from Units per month. Items may not exceed four (4) feet in any two (2) dimensions and must be able to be safely handled by two people, as determined by the sole discretion of the Company. Units requiring collection of additional Bulky and/or White Good items may contact WM to schedule an appointment and make payment for additional eligible items. Units receiving any extra services will bear the full cost of any such services provided by Company.

Additional bulky items will cost \$20.00 each, and additional White goods items will cost \$20.00 each.

Unacceptable Bulk & White Goods Waste

Bulk item collection does NOT include additional regular trash bags, air conditioners, and regulated material covered by the New York State Electronic Equipment Recycling and Reuse Act, such as televisions and computers.

Dead animals, explosive and flammable materials, compressed gas cylinders, aerosol cans, motor oils, regulated and non-regulated hazardous waste. Pathological, medical, infectious, construction, remodeling, septic waste, sludge, junk automobiles, and recreational vehicles (ATVs). **TIRES ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**
