

Get to know the Island of Moorea

French Polynesia includes 118 islands, spread over a surface area larger than Europe in the South Pacific Ocean, and divided into five archipelagos including the Society Islands, the Tuamotu Islands, the Gambier Archipelago, the Marquesas Islands and the Austral Archipelago.

Often called the magic island, Moorea is one of the most romantic and exhilarating destinations in French Polynesia. A real postcard landscape with a crystal lagoon, abundant marine life and a superb coral garden. In Moorea, we live the true experience of the South Seas - white sand beaches and multicolored lagoons surrounded by mountains with sharp peaks where volcanic peaks meet the clouds. Located 17km west of Tahiti, Moorea is a triangular island surrounded by a lagoon and bordered by the azure blue Polynesian Ocean.

Beyond the fine sandy beaches, the island offers a multitude of nature experiences: canoeing, paddleboarding, skiing boating and snorkeling with rays, sharks and sea turtles in the sparkling lagoon. Moorea is the ideal place for hiking, golf, quad biking and exploring the mountains and tropical valleys on four wheels. Cultural tours or discovery of local cuisine also allow an immersion in the daily life of Polynesians.



The Resort

The Sofitel Kia Ora Moorea Beach Resort sits on the edge of the crystal clear lagoon by framed jagged green mountains.

Accessible via a short boatride from Papeete, the resort is located 10 minutes from the ferry dock and the airport, on the eastern side of Moorea, making it the most convenient and one of the best off-Tahiti island experiences.

The resort enjoys a secluded location on the picturesque white sand beach of Temae, the longest of the island, within a protected marine area.

Since 2002, the lagoon which shelters a fauna and a flora of an exceptional diversity, is classified as a Marine Reserve where fishing and corals collection of prohibited as well as all motorized water activities. The stunning natural environment and the overall ambience make for an exceptional experience.

The resort offers a variety of elegant accomodations, 110 including bungalows Garden Bungalows, 9 Ocean view Bungalows, 14 Garden with Beach view Bungalows, 11 Bungalows, Beach Overwater Bungalows and a 2-Bedroom Family Bungalow.

We offer several types of ceremonies to cater to your budget and expectations.


To the Bride, imagine that, dressed in a traditional outfit or your white dress, a traditional canoe comes to pick you up for a sail across the lagoon to your Groom.

You land on the pristine beach and find your other half; the Polynesian priest welcomes you before blessing your union, during which you can pronounce your vows.

He will give you your marriage certificate, which will include your Polynesian names. To close the traditional ceremony, a local orchestra and Tahitian dancers will bring a unique cultural dimension to your celebration that belongs only to you.

The master of ceremonies takes the time to meet you before the ceremony, explains how the event will take place, and above all, reassures you about the course of the ceremony.

Please note that the Traditional Marriage certificate holds no legal value.



The "AUTI" Ceremony

Location: on the Beach **Duration: 40 minutes**

"AUTI" is a sacred plant reserved for blessing ceremonies.

The "Auti" ceremony is our intimate traditional Polynesian celebration, perfect for two.

It will be performed by a Tahitian priest, who will ensure that the ceremony honors the couple's union and connects them to the island's spiritual heritage.

This romantic wedding will take place rather on our beach. Mixing traditions and local touches, our couple will be conducted to meet our "Tahu'a", the local priest, to receive the blessings. The master of ceremony unifies the couple using "Auti" leaves, sacred coconut water, and wrapped "Tifaifai" * to symbolize their traditional union.

Including a musical welcome by a singer and a musician, you will be surrounded by floral decoration on the beach.

Flowercrown and lei are given to the bride and a traditional marriage certificate is delivered at the end.

To end your special day perfectly, after the ritual, a bed of tropical flowers will be waiting for you in your bungalow.

It is representing the couple's connection and the weaving together of their lives and families.



Location: on the Beach or at the Pontoon

Duration: 1 hour

"HEREHIA" is a Tahitian name which means "LOVED".

Make your dreams come true with our Herehia Ceremony, taking place on Temae or at the Pontoon, this ceremony will offer you a deeply authentic and cultural experience.

The wedding coordinator meets you in your Bungalow to escort you to the choosen venue celebration, dressed up with flower crowns and leis necklaces.

The bride will be offered her wedding bouquet.

Banquets

Musicians, dancers and singers will welcome you with the sounds of ukuleles and Polynesian loves song.

The priest will baptized the couple with Polynesian names, using sacred coconut water.

The couple will receive then the last benediction, surrounded by locals performing typical Polynesian dances and songs to celebrate the couple's love.

The newlyweds will be invited to taste a fresh Tropical Cocktail to celebrate their traditional union.

A traditional marriage certificate will be delivered at the end of the ceremony.

"TE ORA NO MOOREA" means "Life in Moorea".

The ceremony is a beautiful blend of luxury and tradition, offering couples an unforgettable way to celebrate their love amidst the stunning scenery and rich culture of Moorea.

It will offers a truly immersive and culturally rich experience and is designed to honor the couple's union with elements that reflect the natural beauty and spiritual heritage of Moorea.

During the "Te Ora no Moorea" ceremony, a Tahitian priest performs traditionnal Polynesian wedding customs.

The arrival is done by canoe on the beach, and a traditionnal outfit with pareo and flowercrown is elaborated with the help of our team to fit the bride's wants.

A local tropical flowers bouquet is offered to the bride and the bungalow is also decorated with a flower bed.

The beach is moreover decorated with fresh and colorful tropical flowers.

An exotic cocktail is provided on the beach while music is playing and dances can be appreciated. This package also includes a romantic dinner by the lagoon with Champagne.

Legal Wedding Ceremony

Sofitel Kia Ora Moorea Beach Resort provides experienced wedding coordinators for your civil ceremony.

They can assist in planning every detail, from arranging the legal requirements for civil weddings to coordinating with vendors for floral arrangements, photography, music, and catering.

The team ensures that the ceremony and reception reflect the couple's vision, whether it's a small, intimate affair or a large, lavish celebration.

As per the "Conditions" to get married in French Polynesia, both spouses:

- > must be at least 18 years old,
- > cannot be already married in France or overseas,
- > cannot be related by direct lineage (i.r. marriage between ascendants, descendants and allies in the same lineage),
- > cannot be of French origin or have French residential status in France or its territories,
- > must be physically present during the marriage ceremony to give their consent,
- > The bride and the groom must each choose a witness (who must be 18 years of age or older please note, if the chosen witnesses are not present, the mayor will appoint a witness),
- > A translator/interpreter is present at the ceremony.

To formalize your union, we will be delighted to assist you with the following documents required:

- > The « Marriage of Foreign Citizens in The Islands of Tahiti » must be completed and be translated in French & legalised (precifying the provisions of the foreign law),
- > A letter signed and dated by both future spouses, addressed to the mayor of the commune chosen for the marriage ceremony, noting which language the ceremony will take placein.
- > Proof of identity of both of the future spouses (copies of their passports).
- > A certified copy of both spouses' birth certificate authenticated with an "Apostille" (note: the birth certificates must have been issued less than 6 months prior to the date of the marriage).

Both of the birth certificates and the "Apostille" must be translated into French by an approved translator and legalized by the French Consulate. Translators can be found on the consulate'swebsite.


> A "Certificate of Non-Marital Status" ("Certificat de celibat") signed by lawyer, translated into French and legalized by the French Consulate.

Lawyers can be found on the consulate'swebsite.


- > Proof of residency for both of the future spouses (a utility bill or any bill noting names and physical address will suffice). A photocopy of bills for both spouses isacceptable.
- > Optional, if a prenuptial agreement has been created, it must be translated into French and authenticated by the French Consulate.

Please be informed that the documents have to be sent 1 month and 10 days before the ceremony.


Our fine dining restaurant offers a buffet as well as thoughfully crafted menus specially designed by the Chef to accommodate dietary restrictions.


The open bar is open for one hour, and offers several drink packages available for the cocktail party. Each selection includes non-alcoholic drinks.


The Infinite Pool Lounge

Facing the breathtaking views of Tahiti and the sparkling beach, the "Infinite Pool Lounge" offers an exquisite setting for your wedding celebration.


Situated close to the Resort's vibrant bar, this venue is perfect for entertaining your guests during a festive evening.

Buffet

Banquet buffets offer limited quantities of food. Food preparation is based on one serving per person. Additional servings may be purchased at additional charge. Please note twenty (20) person minimum required for buffets. Buffets have a two (2)-hour time limit due to the weather elements and effects on food. Food can be refreshed for extensions on this time limit at a cost-per-person.

Food and beverages

All food and beverage items must be purchased exclusively from Sofitel Kia Ora Moorea Beach Resort and consumed in the designated function areas. Sofitel Kia Ora Moorea Beach Resort is the only licensed authority to serve and sell alcoholic beverages on the grounds, therefore outside alcoholic beverages are not permitted on Resort property.

Meal substitutions

It is our intent to accommodate any requests according to dietary requirements. These must be provided seven (7) business days prior to the function. Requests received within the seven (7) business days period will be accommodated at an additional charge.

Menu selection

If menu selections are not completed a minimum of three (3) weeks prior to the function date, prices may be subject to change.

Equipment

Audio visual, lighting and entertainment equipment is available through our Events Department located at the Resort. Rental and set-up fees apply.

Providers

It is entirely possible to call on any providers of your choosing for your event. If necessary, our team is delighted to suggest trusted and reliable providers as well.

Guarantee

A guaranteed guest count is required twenty-one (21) days prior to the function. We will prepare for up to five percent (5%) over your guaranteed guest count for func-tions of 100 people or more. You will be charged for your guaranteed guest count or your actual guest attendance, whichever is greater. If we are not advised of a gua-ranteed count, the tentative number of guests will become the guaranteed count.

Corporate branding

Signs and hospitality/registration tables in public areas, the arrival pavilion, or adjacent to guest suites are prohibited. Signs outside hospitality suites or function space are to be professionally printed no larger than 20" x 24" and approved by the Resort. The posting of any items (posters, signs, banners etc.) on any function room walls or doors is strictly prohibited - arrangements can be made for easels. Participant nametags are permitted in private meeting and event locations and are prohibited in public areas.


