"Cassis, blue plums and purple flowers followed by pencil lead, vanilla and cocoa powder with an underlying rocky minerality. Creamy and full-bodied with soft acidity and firm yet ripe tannins. Well-framed wine with nice concentration and structure.

"Generous, full-bodied with ripe, firm tannins and mineral-laced brambly red and black-toned fruits nuanced by tobacco, bay leaf, and fragrant sagebrush. The tannins build with intensity on the palate, softened by good acid tension, and the finish is punctuated by perfumed rose petals and cinnamon."
