Uncle Nearest 1884 Small Batch Whiskey is a 93-proof whiskey distilled, aged, and bottled entirely by Uncle Nearest. Each batch is curated by 5th generation Nearest Green descendant and our Master Blender, Victoria Eady Butler, who has been named Master Blender of the Year four times over.

1884 Small Batch presents with a lively nose of honey, warm brown sugar, cedar, orange peel, tobacco flower, ground ginger, and white pepper. On the palate, it warms, showing caramel balanced with spicy wood tannins, with notes of baking chocolate, cigar leaf, nougat, and cinnamon. The finish is long and smooth. The cinnamon lingers with dark chocolate, oak tannins, and maple syrup. A fantastic sipper, yet versatile enough for all your favorite cocktails.

Uncle Nearest Premium Whiskey has garnered more than 1450 awards and accolades throughout the world since the brand's July 2017 debut, including the coveted Double Gold award at the 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024 San Francisco World Spirits Competitions as well as being named Best Tennessee Whiskey. Uncle Nearest has earned 155 Best in Class honors, including Spirit Brand of the Year from Wine Enthusiast, two Chairman's Trophies from Ultimate Spirits Challenge, Whisky of the Year from USA Spirits Ratings, the Master Medal from American Whiskey Masters, and 3x honors of "World's Best" from the World Whiskies Awards.

THE STORY

Nearest Green, affectionately nicknamed Uncle Nearest by his friends and family in Lynchburg, Tennessee, is the world's first known African American master distiller. Nearest Green is credited with helping perfect the globally recognized Lincoln County Process, which is the defining distinction between Kentucky Bourbon and Tennessee Whiskey. This unique filtering of whiskey through sugar maple charcoal was named after the county where Nearest lived and made his highly regarded Bourbon.

Nearest Green Distillery is the world's first distillery to commemorate an African American and the #7 most-visited distillery in the world. Dubbed as "Malt Disney World," and named by Travel + Leisure as a "true whiskey destination," the 458-acre property has become known as a full-blown destination for whiskey lovers, history enthusiasts, and families. It is a master class in storytelling and history-making, paying tribute to the three things Tennessee is most known for: Tennessee Whiskey, Tennessee walking horses, and Tennessee music.
