With over 13,000 students and staff representing 120+ nationalities, the University of Bradford is a vibrant campus community. Yet, navigating the university's multi-site estate had become a challenge. Static maps and inconsistent signage were no longer keeping pace with the needs of students, staff, and visitors. Bradford sought a future-ready solution that could improve accessibility, integrate with digital systems, and be managed internally without relying on outdated processes.



CHALLENGES



- **Outdated signage:** Physical maps and signs were difficult to keep updated, leading to confusion across campus.
- Accessibility concerns: Students and visitors needed a reliable way to find classrooms, services, and facilities.
- Fragmented systems: Room bookings, event information, and departmental data were scattered across platforms.
- Student experience: As incoming cohorts increasingly expect digital-first services, the university wanted a solution to match the usability of outdoor mapping tools.

SOLUTION

To overcome these challenges, the University of Bradford partnered with MazeMap, the leading provider of interactive indoor maps and navigation. The project began with a soft launch just before the academic year, ensuring students could benefit immediately.
