



A GROWING PROBLEM

Men and boys struggle to find roles outside of restrictive stereotypes.

Boys are socialised into norms, which encourage violence, excuse sexual harassment and sexism, leave little space for them to explore who they are, and discourage them from seeking help or building healthy relationships. This leads to problems for them and broader society, such as...

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

Three training sessions, designed for different cohorts:

- Teacher Training: 3hrs, Understanding youth masculinities and behavioural outcomes.
- Youth Worker: 1.5 days, Professional development tackling consequences of masculinities.
- Youth Leaders: 4hrs, Foundational training in safe & inclusive groups. Action planning.

OUTCOMES

Build professional teams and community leaders who recognise the impact of pressures and gendered norms on boys and young men, and are able to intervene to create safer, healthier and more inclusive social norms.

PILOT OPTIONS FOR YOUR PACKAGE

Design a package of workshops to reach a selected cohort, testing the impact of our work:

- Assemblies: 1hr, Broad reach, large group (20-100) online, presentation, 12-19yr
- Pupil Workshop: 3 x 2hrs, Deep work, small groups (<20), in person, workshop, 12-19yr
- Team Talk: 2hrs, Foundational, small group (<20), online/in person, 18-35yr
- Youth Leadership: 4hrs, Foundational, small group (<20), online/in person, leaders

OUTCOMES

Surfacing and unpacking of the stereotypes of masculinities felt by young people in your communities, enabling them to identify positive and harmful outcomes of these gender norms, and develop alternative group and individual norms.

Will create organisational buy in for future expansion of local hubs, by running workshops with schools, universities and/or community organisations.


