What is AHDO Professional Certification?


AHDO is the organisation to promote and support human development professionals in the workplace. As an ASEAN organisation, we created the world's first certification programme for professionals. What's in it for you?

Learning Roadmap

The programme is a half-year process that concludes with an individual certification interview and a team action learning project presentation.

The yellow sections represent formal learning modules while the blue sections represent immersion sessions. The yellow square at the end represents the individual interview for certification.



The workshops and webinars sessions will cover the essential knowledge needed to be a human development professional for the world of work in different kinds of organisations and institutions



AHDO Facilitators



AHDO is a community of human development professionals working in different countries and sectors internationally. Certification Course Leaders who are regional human development experts work together to team teach each cohort of participants for the learning sessions, action learning projects, individualised career planning, and as assessors for certification.

Certification

Certification encompasses all the components of the programme: knowledge, capability, action learning and career development. The purpose of certification is validate that you are a human development professional – it is your professional credential and is given after assessment of your capability, ethics and career positioning.



AHDO certification takes place in interview format with assessment and recommendations by a panel made up of the following:

- 1. Certification Course Leaders
- 2. Your AHDO Facilitators
- 3. Your Course Peers

Certification is assessed according to quality criteria for active participation, delivering course assignments, project work and career plan.

Time Commitment and Certification Requirements

AHDO certification programmes are designed to fit the schedule of working professionals. Webinars are organised on Saturday afternoons.

The sessions are scheduled for 2 hours and may extend to 2 ½ hours for modules.

The estimated time commitment for assignments is ½ day preparation for each of the 9 modules, plus time invested with your action learning team and writing your Personal Enterprise Plan.



To be certified, participants must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Attend at least 7 of the 9 sessions (maximum 2 absences before elimination)
- 2. Participate actively in online discussions during the modules (with screen on)
- 3. For the PEP assignment, write a Personal Enterprise Plan with at least 2 coaching sessions with a course Facilitator of choice
- 4. For the team Action Learning Assignment, define a specific role for contribution to the project and demonstrate active collaboration.

Certification is validated by a panel of at least 2 qualified Assessors. There are 2 certification interviews: a team assessment for the Action Learning Project of 2 hours and an individual interview of 90 minutes.



In cases where participants cannot attend 7 of the 9 sessions for a valid reason such as illness, intensive travel or career change, it is possible to complete the certification requirements in the next cohort.

Schedule of Sessions and Module Content

This schedule avoids all major public holidays for Singapore, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Philippines, Vietnam, Myanmar, Cambodia, Brunei, and Laos. Each Saturday session falls on a date that does not overlap with the principal national or religious holidays for any of these ASEAN member states. The course timing was specifically arranged to be suitable and non-conflicting for participants in all ASEAN countries: Chinese New Year, Eid al-Fitr, Vesak Day, Hari Raya Haji, Songkran, Tet, and other important regional holidays.

Note: the facilitators for the different modules may be changed in the scheduling.
