

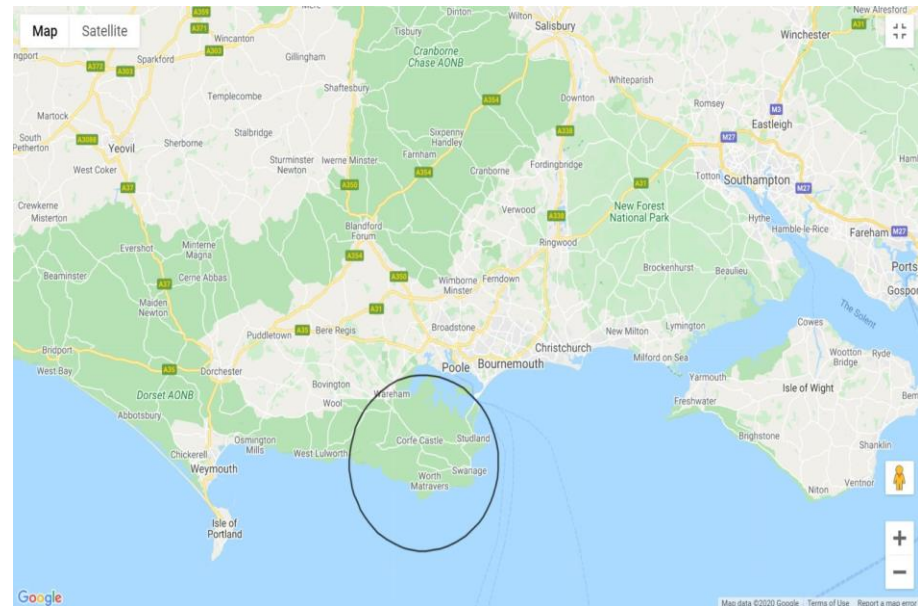

Sausage, bacon and beans. Pancakes, waffles, bacon and cheese turnovers.



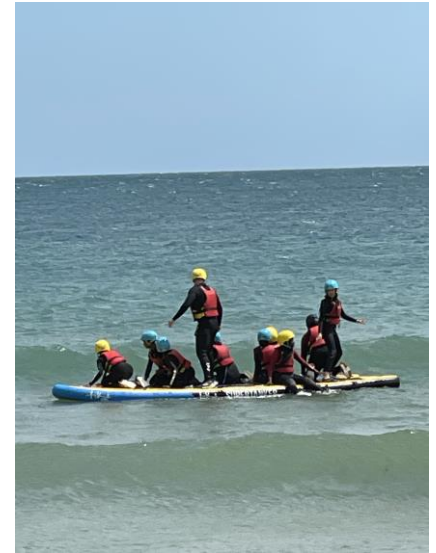

Risk Assessments
