Fees	Office fee per horse: \$10.00   Regular Class: \$10.00   Ranch Riding & Reining: \$15.00. (Classes 38, 39 & 40) <b>Championship Class: \$15.00   Stalls: \$75.00</b> (with 2 bags of shavings). <b>No Fee</b> for the following class numbers: 20, 21 & 22
Awards	Ribbons will be presented through sixth (6 <sup>th</sup> ) place in each class
Dress	Proper show attire is recommended for all classes: <i>boots, and collared shirts sleeves are required.</i> Jackets are optional due to the summer heat.
Rules	Canter/loping riders may not show walk-trot/jog. Classes will be run and adjudicated based on the current USEF Rulebook. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are final and cannot be protested. Show Management reserves the right to ask any exhibitor to leave the show grounds for any reason, including but not limited, to unsportsmanlike conduct and animal cruelty.
Schooling Classes	Horses are allowed to wear schooling tack ( <i>martingales, draw reins, leg-wraps. etc.</i> ) and will be judged.
Schooling Horses	Horses wearing schooling tack ( <i>martingales, draw reins, leg-wraps etc.</i> ) will be allowed in regular classes <b>but will not be judged</b> . Schooling exhibitors should wear appropriate attire and <i>wear numbers upside-down.</i>
