General Information

This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the Rules of the USEF, particularly the American Saddlebred, Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian Horse Divisions, and the rules of the American Saddlebred Association, and Arabian Horse Association (AHA). The official rulebook of each organization will prevail over this show. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of these rules and is subject to these rules. Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this prize list. Questions that may arise that are not covered by either AHA or USEF rulebooks will be decided by the Show Committee, and their decisions will be final.

Under Arizona law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities. Pursuant to A.R.S. §12-553

Horses shown in breed divisions must have been issued a certificate of Registration from the American Saddlebred Association and/or the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc. (or in the case of a foreign entry, have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Horse Registry of America) and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry and registration applied for and must be entered Under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers.) All entries, except in equitation and showmanship classes must be serviceably sound. A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership MUST be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry. In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of the sale or lease, or a statement from owner be submitted with a copy of the registration papers. All entries must be in good condition. Horses with loss of sight in one eye may compete in performance classes only.

Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian horses will be allowed in the Half-Arabian classes only (except where otherwise specifically stated) and must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or the Anglo-Arabian Registry, or a Canadian Half-Arabian registration paper. AND MUST BE ENTERED UNDER THEIR FULL REGISTERED NAME. PHOTOCOPY OF BOTH SIDES OF THE REGISTRATION PAPERS OF EACH HORSE MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE ENTRY FORM. A FEE OF \$25.00 WILL BE CHARGED FOR EACH HORSE WITHOUT COPY SUBMITTED WITH ENTRY.

ACADEMY CLASSES: The purpose of this division is to introduce potential new equestrians to the joys of showing and riding horses by giving beginners in any breed an opportunity to gain experience. 1. Horses are NOT judged. Horses in the Academy classes MUST be lesson horses used regularly in a professionally operated lesson program. These horses must display the characteristics of such. 2. All Academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the RIDER to control and show their horses to the best advantage. 3. **Academy Equitation**

classes are judged on BASIC equitation skills with correct diagonals and leads. 4. **Academy Showmanship** classes should be judged on the rider's horsemanship abilities. The horse is NOT supposed to be judged. It should be judged on the rider's ability to control and show their horse. Promptness in finding the correct diagonals and canter leads is important as well as the rider's command of the horse; for example: speed, placement in the ring and collection. 5. Headers are allowed in the 9 & 10 and 8 & Under Walk/Trot classes only after the judges' cards have been turned in. No towels, whips or aids of any kind are allowed. 6. Disputes shall be submitted in writing to Show Management, whose decisions are final. RIDERS: 1. No full riding suits allowed (no hats, derbies, or jackets). Neat Jodhpurs with dress shirt and Jodhpur boots are required. Vest and tie are optional. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or without penalty from the judge. Helmets required for exhibitors aged 17 and under. 2. Riders must be participating in a professionally operated program and show on lesson horses. 3. A rider may own his/her horse as long as the horse is REGULARLY used in a lesson program. 4. A rider who has shown in a regular division or in a full suit is prohibited from further participation in the Academy division with the exception of Show Rider Practice. 5. Once a rider has shown in Walk/Trot/Canter classes, a return to Walk/Trot classes is prohibited. You cannot show in Walk/Trot/Canter and Walk/Trot at the same show. Riders showing in Walk only may not show in Walk/Trot. 6. Academy riders may not show in any other division at the same show with the exception of driving classes. HORSES: 1. Horses must be flat/keg shod. Corrective shoeing will be allowed without excessive pads. Soundness is not to be considered. 2. Horses may be shown in snaffle bridles with martingales. Pelham and curb type bits (martingales discouraged) are allowed at the discretion of the instructor. Please use caution when fitting horses for beginners. Flat cutback English type saddles are to be used, unless the calls for alternative tack, such as Western or Hunt. 3. Academy horses may be cross entered into show divisions at the same show. Show horses (horses not used in a professional lesson program and shown regularly in show performance or equitation classes) may not be cross entered into the Academy Division. Academy Entries do not have to be AHA or USEF members but will have to pay the office and grounds or stall fees.

ADMISSION TO RING - There will be an assigned "Order of Go" in all "Breeding/Halter and In-Hand" qualifying classes. The "Order of Go" shall be determined and posted by each horse's Birth Date, oldest to youngest. Due to the changes in USEF rules for Breeding/Halter and In-Hand Competition, the prescribed "Order of Go" must be adhered to. Horses entering the ring in the wrong order or who have missed entering the arena in the assigned order will be eliminated from competition. It is the exhibitors/handler's responsibility to enter the arena in the posted "Order of Go".

AHA MEDAL CLASSES - See USEF Rulebook for specifications.

AHA Membership - All owners, trainers, riders, drivers, and handlers must be a current Competition Level Member of the Arabian Horse Association or pay a Single Event Membership of \$40 per person. Walk/trot & leadline riders are exempt from this. Single Event Members shall only have exhibiting privileges for the duration of the event where the membership is purchased.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT - EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

ALCOHOL - IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON OR ORGANIZATION TO BRING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON TO THE PREMISES. ALL ALCOHOL MUST BE PURCHASED THROUGH AHAA OR DESIGNATED VENDOR. NO EXCEPTIONS. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

AMATEUR STATUS - Every amateur having reached their 19th birthday by December 1 must possess a current USEF Amateur card. Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification, Amateur cards are no longer available for non-members. Any person who enters the show ring in any class without having their USEF Amateur card on file in the show office will be assessed a \$100 fine and will be disqualified from the class. A handler change form will be invalid if the amateur card has not been provided to the show office prior to the class. Combined ownership is not permitted in Amateur Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. Leased horses are not eligible for amateur owner classes.

ATTENDANTS, DUTIES AND APPEARANCE - All Attendants in charge of horses or assisting with the preparation and showing of the horses, will be subject to orders of the Horse Show Manager. All Attendants MUST be suitably and neatly dressed when entering the ring. Exhibitor must be correctly attired for the class, and Attendants be neatly dressed and horses properly presented.

AWARDS - Qualifying classes will award Ribbons to sixth place in all classes except equitation ribbons to eighth place. Championship classes ribbon to Champion, Reserve Champion and the remainder of Top Seven. Academy classes will give out 6 ribbons in each class.

AWARDS POINTS - This show is sanctioned by the Arabian Horse Association, enabling exhibitors to receive points for the AHA Achievement Awards.

BAROQUE/GYPSY HORSE CLASSES - These are non-USEF Rated classes. Baroque horses are a type of light, agile and strong horse, descended from the athletic horses of the Baroque era, but can include Gypsy Horses for the purposes of this show. Typical breeds included: Andalusian, Friesian, Ginetta, Lusitano, and Lipizzaner. Horses may be shown in: Dressage, Saddle Type, Hunt Seat, or Western.

CLASS CALLS - Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the public address system must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working public address system to carry class calls. As the first horse enters the in-gate, a two-minute time rule shall be enforced. Exhibitors should notify the ring announcer AND gate personnel if a tack change is required.

COGGINS, HEALTH CERTIFICATE & VACCINATIONS - **Mandatory for all horses coming onto the WestWorld property as per Arizona state law:** All horses 6 months of age and older must have proof of a negative Coggins (*dated within the previous twelve months*) and horses from out of state must have a valid Health Certificate (*dated within the previous thirty days*). Coggins, Health certificate and Vaccinations must match the horse being entered into the show and must include a complete description of the horse and must specify the home location of the horse. **Horses will not be permitted on the WestWorld property without the submission of a Coggins, Health Certificate and Vaccination records. Horses caught on the property without necessary paperwork will be asked to leave the grounds and will not be given a refund of any fees. PLEASE SUBMIT A COPY OF THE PAPERWORK WITH ENTRIES AND HAVE ORIGINAL COPY WITH YOU AS INSPECTIONS MAY BE DONE by show officials or designated representatives from the City of Scottsdale. Back numbers will not be released until show office has copy of Coggins, Health Certificates and Vaccination records. ANY EXHIBITOR, TRAINER, OWNER WHO KNOWINGLY BRINGS A SICK HORSE ONTO THE SHOW GROUNDS WILL BE LIABLE FOR ALL DAMAGES INCLUDING BUT LIMITED TO NEGATIVE FINANCIAL IMPACT ON THE SHOW, HORSES, THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE AND THE ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION OF ARIZONA. USEF EQUINE VACINATION RULE:** All Federation licensed competitions; horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (*Rhinopneumonitis*) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines be administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds.

These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested. 5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee. BOD 1/17/15 Effective 12/1/15. Horses caught on property without necessary paperwork will be asked to leave the grounds and will not be given a refund of any fees. PLEASE SUBMIT A COPY OF THE PAPERWORK WITH ENTRIES AND HAVE ORIGINAL COPY WITH YOU AS INSPECTIONS WILL BE DONE. Back numbers will not be released until show office has copy.

COMMERCIAL EXHIBITORS - Fee \$50.00/day. This amount is for an area approximately 10ft. x 10ft. Set-up may begin at 2:00 p.m. Thursday prior to the show and be totally complete by 8:30 a.m. the morning of the show. Display must be removed entirely no later than Sunday, November 10th at 7pm. AHAA will not be responsible for merchandise or display on the grounds prior to, during or preceding the show. For further information or to make reservations: (480) 515-1500.

COMPETITION AREAS - Dimensions - Equidome Arena: 135' x 290'; Wendell Arena: 180' x 360'; 3, 4, 5, 5A, 6,7,8 & 9:150' x 300'. ALL ARENAS have native clay and sand composition.

CONTROLLED PADDOCK - The one specified person assisting with entrance of in-hand horses into the ring will be allowed to use only the same length whip and appendages as are currently allowed for the individual handling the horse. Rule reference AR114.2: Whips are to be no longer than 6' including snapper/lash/appendage. Small appendages (no more than 12 inches in length) of ribbon, plastic, etc. are permitted. The designated person will not hit or use any other objects, such as trash cans, walls, etc., to make any noise. In addition, *effective immediately*, the use of plastic or paper bags of any type or size is prohibited in assisting with entrance(s) into the arena. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to abide by and understand this policy. Should this rule/policy be violated, a warning card may be issued to both the handler and the designated person or groom who initiates this violation.

COPIES OF USEF, ASB, AND AHA MEMBERSHIP CARDS - AHA has resolved that owners, trainers, riders, drivers, handlers must provide a photocopy of their current AHA and USEF membership card with their entry form. AHA no longer accepts affidavits, membership cards must be shown or a single event fee must be paid. Anyone not having an AHA card must pay the non-member/single event fees. Members of ASB must provide a photocopy of their current membership card with their entry form.

DIRECTIONS to WESTWORLD – 16601 N. Pima Road, Scottsdale, AZ North of Frank Lloyd Wright Boulevard - Pima Frontage Road is for northbound traffic only.

North (Flagstaff): I-17 South to SR-101 Loop - Eastbound into Scottsdale. Take the Pima/Princess exit. Make a left at Bell Road (second light) Continue east on Bell Road. Turn right on 94 Street. Travel south to the WestWorld entrance.

South (Tucson): I-10 to US-60 (Superstition Freeway). US-60 East to SR-101 Loop. SR-101 North to Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd. Exit at Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd., move to the far-right lane. Continue straight, crossing the Frank Lloyd Wright intersection. WestWorld entrance is ½ block north on the right at large horse statue.

DISCIPLINE - Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, trainer, rider, driver or member of the family of the person participating in the show, will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a groom, horse, rider, trainer or driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive or made with intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging, and any exhibitor may be barred from the show for this offense by the Show Committee.

DISQUALIFICATION - Refer to current USEF Rule book. Any horses doctored in any way artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show ring will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made, any false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. In case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in the class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified horse.

DISPUTE NOT COVERED BY RULES - Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the governing rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee, whose decision will be final.

DOGS - Scottsdale City Ordinance requires dogs to be on a leash at all times. THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED WITHOUT WARNING. Any pet in stall area must be on a leash or secured. No pets allowed in show office or arenas. Owner assumes all liability for pet animals.

DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS - The drugs and medication Rule contained in the USEF Rule Book will be enforced. Horses in competition will be subject to examination by a licensed veterinarian appointed by USEF. Said appointed licensed veterinarian, with approval of the USEF, may appoint a technician to perform certain duties Under USEF rules. The examination may include physical, saliva, urine, blood tests or any other test or procedure at the discretion of said licensed veterinarian necessary to effectuate the purposes of this rule. These representatives must be treated with respect. CAUTION: REFUSAL TO SUBMIT A HORSE FOR EXAMINATION, WHETHER IN COMPETITION OR NOT, AND TO COOPERATE WITH THE VETERINARIAN AND TECHNICIANS UNTIL THE SAMPLES HAVE BEEN TAKEN CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION AND SUBJECTS THE RESPONSIBLE PERSON TO THE PENALTIES UNDER THE RULES.

EXCESSIVE USE OF THE WHIP ON ANY HORSE IN A STALL, RUNWAY, SCHOOLING AREA, SHOW RING OR ELSEWHERE ON THE COMPETITION BEFORE OR DURING A SHOW, BY ANY PERSON, CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION AND RENDERS THE OFFENDER SUBJECT TO PENALTY. JUDGES WILL BE EXPECTED TO ENFORCE THIS IN THE ARENA.

ENTRIES - Entries must be on the official entry form or a photocopy of the form for this show. Copy of horse's registration papers must accompany all entries. All horse(s) entered belonging to one owner must be entered on one entry form (additional entry form sheets may be attached). No horse may be entered on more than one entry form. The complete name and address of the registered owner must appear in the space entitled OWNER INFORMATION. One, and only one, owner can appear on each entry form. Farm name may not be used unless (1) the stable or farm is the bona fide owner appearing on the horse's registration papers, or (2) the stable or farm name has been registered with USEF and the number shown on the USEF certificate is noted in the space provided. If a farm name is used as Owner, the farm must have an AHA Farm/Ranch Membership and that Farm/Ranch Membership Number must be used as the Owner AHA or ASB number. A copy of the Farm/Ranch membership card must accompany the entry. Owner, trainer and rider must sign the entry form in the spaces provided. If owner, trainer and rider are the same, owner must sign in both spaces. (Trainer is "any adult who has the responsibility for the care, training, custody or performance of a horse"). The permission for a minor to show section on the entry form must be completed with birth date of junior exhibitor and signature of parent or guardian.

Equine Health Precautions – Effective July 1, 2014 – A negative Coggins, dated within the previous twelve months, must accompany all horses brought onto WestWorld property; A Health Certificate, dated within the previous thirty days, must be presented for any horse originating outside of Arizona; Event management shall verify all paperwork.

EXHIBITIONS - All exhibitions to be placed between classes will be at the discretion of the Show Committee.

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION - Electronic communication devices used for the purpose of coaching, etc., between competitors and individuals outside the ring shall be prohibited in all classes in the Arabian Division. Exempt from this rule are handicapped riders who have submitted written proof to the USEF Steward.

FARRIER - A Farrier will be on the grounds during all performances.

FEED & BEDDING - Arrangements have been made for feed to be available at regular competitive prices and delivered to stalls. Exhibitors will be provided with the best quality Feed & Bedding at a reasonable cost. The Barn Manager will provide exhibitors with instructions concerning handling of feed and bedding in stalls and barn aisles. No pre-bedding will be provided, all bedding will need to be purchased through the WestWorld Feed and Bedding office. POSITIVELY NO STRAW WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. Feed & Bedding Hours: Wednesday 1:00pm – 5:00pm, Thursday 8:00am – 5:00pm, Friday 8:00am – 4:00pm, Saturday 8:00am – 4:00pm, Sunday 8:00am – approx. 12:00pm. WW Feed & Bedding Phone Number: 480.312.6814

FIRST AID - First aid treatment will be available during all performances.

FOOTING - ALL ARENAS HAVE native clay and sand composition.

FUN CLASSES - Fun classes are for entertainment only, we may have:

Bouncy Horse Races for all ages. Everyone is welcome to attend!

Egg and Spoon (*Awards ONLY – No Money Needed*) Each rider will be given an egg and a spoon, they cannot touch the base of the spoon or the egg. Each rider will take the rail and will be instructed to perform different gates. The class will continue and get increasingly harder until there is one rider left that still has the egg in the spoon, that rider will win.

Musical Cones on Horseback (*Awards Only – No Money Needed*) Each rider will be mounted, riders to ride in a circular pattern around the cones. When the music stops you must have your horse beside a cone. One cone will be removed after each time the music has stopped. Last rider beside a cone wins.

GROUNDS FEES - A \$50.00 charge will be assessed to each horse trailered in and not assigned a stall on the show grounds.

HALTER CLASSES: All halter classes (excluding Sport horse) will utilize the Comparative Single Judge System.

HIGH-POINT - A Trainer High point will be offered at the show. The High-point winner will receive \$250. All divisions will count towards the high-point. The following high-point system will be used. **HIGH POINT SCORING SYSTEM** – A 10-point descending scale will be used for qualifying classes as follows: 10 points for 1st place, 9 points for 2nd place etc. in classes with fewer than 10 entries, the winner shall receive the point value equal to the number of horses in the class (i.e., 5 in class, 1st place = 5 points, 2nd Place = 4 points, 3rd Place = 3 points, 4th Place = 2 points, 5th Place = 1 point), not to exceed 10 points per class. Points for Championship classes will be awarded as follows: Champion 15 points, Reserve 12 points and Top Ten will receive 10 points each. The rule for breaking ties will be as follows: 1. High Point Award to be awarded to the trainer/breeder who has won the most championships. 2. If the tie remains, the reserve championship awards will be counted. 3. In the event the tie still remains, the award will be given to the trainer/breeder who has then won the most first place awards in classes of five or more exhibitors. 4. In the event the tie is still not resolved, the exhibitors second place awards will be counted.

HOOF INSPECTION - Random inspection of shoes, pads and hoof length by appropriate show officials, in the presence of the trainer, may be done at the discretion of the show management. Champion and Reserve Champions may be inspected.

INSURANCE ADVISORY - Due to the number and quality of horses at the ACC Show, we urge each exhibitor to verify their liability insurance coverage, and their livestock mortality coverage, with their own insurance carrier(s). Be sure your coverage is in effect. The Show and the Arabian Horse Association of Arizona, its members, agents, employees, and volunteers accept no responsibility for any losses, injuries or actions caused by any individual.

HORSES ON GROUNDS - Horses not entered in the Show are not permitted on the show grounds unless they have entered the show must be filled out in conjunction with an entry form and entries must be submitted prior to arrival on the grounds. If the horse is not entered into the show the fee is \$250 and will be strictly enforced (stall charges are not included in this fee). Horses that are not registered Arabian or Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian will not be allowed on the grounds even if the application is submitted this policy will be strictly enforced.

JUDGES - In the event that due to an illness or failure of a Judge to attend the show or to perform their duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a Judge for the one who is officially designated in the Premium List, according to current USEF Rules. No contact shall be made with Judges during the period of the show unless accompanied by a member of the Show Committee designated by the Committee for such purpose. Further, no exhibitor shall approach a Judge regarding a decision unless he first obtains permission from the Steward, who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

JUDGING SYSTEM - The Single Judge Comparative Scoring System as outlined in the current AHA Handbook will be utilized for all halter and performance classes with the exception of Reining, Ranch Riding, Sport Horse, and all others that have a specialized scoring system.

LEVELING DIVISION –When Leveling classes are offered a rider may enter their appropriate level or opt to enter a higher level instead. This show will allow exhibitors to enter their appropriate achievement level and/or any higher level(s) (all appropriate qualifications would be required, if applicable). Riders who are deemed Choice by their leveling points may not level down to Select. In addition, Elite riders may not level down to Choice or Select. In Working Western Classes where levels are run concurrently, a show may elect to allow riders to enter up (not down) in all levels in which appropriate qualifications and entry fees are applied in any circumstance. It is the rider's responsibility to enter the correct level and must submit their AHA leveling records with their entry form. If you have questions about your level you are encouraged to contact AHA directly for verification 303.696.4500.

LOCATION OF CLASSES - Management reserves the right to change the arena location of classes with the proper notification to exhibitors concerned.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES - Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

MOVE-IN/OUT OF HORSES - STALLS –Stalls will be available for move-in at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 12th, and must be vacated on Monday, November 17th by 6:00 am. No early arrivals.

NON-RESPONSIBILITY AND INDEMNITY - All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Arabian Horse Association of Arizona will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of equipment of any kind. All horses shall be Under the control and direction of the Show Committee solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animals or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Arabian Horse Association of Arizona, the City of Scottsdale and the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to, any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. Exhibitors, grooms, handlers, owners, etc. are hereby warned that they may not use any device or conduct which may cause harm to any other person(s) horses, or equipment. THE SUBMITTING OF AN ENTRY FORM TO THE SECRETARY SHALL CONSTITUTE AN ACCEPTANCE BY EACH PERSON SIGNING SAME OF THE PROVISIONS HEREIN SET FORTH.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN A CLASS - Any class with less than three entries may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be combined with another class or cancelled, and the exhibitors in the class(es) will be notified accordingly. Large classes may be divided and conducted as two separate classes with duplicate prizes and awards, except for Championship performance classes.

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES - To be held in accordance with USEF GR139, 407.1, 821, 901.9. Open to all Breeds and Riders. Horses and/or riders/drivers/handlers entered in Opportunity Classes can cross-enter into the rated/recognized classes only if Federation and breed requirements are met. If cross-entering into Federation classes, all Federation fees, and membership requirements must be met. Horses entered only in opportunity classes are exempt from the Federation fee, including the Equine Drugs and Medication fee. Riders/drivers/handlers entered only in opportunity classes are exempt from the Federation membership requirements. No USEF points can be earned in Opportunity Classes.

PARKING - Any vehicle, truck or trailer, within the fenced area of the barn/arena area, or not obeying "NO PARKING" or "FIRE LANE" signs in other parts of the grounds will be subject to towing and impounding at owner's expense and will also be subject to citations and/or towing by the City of Scottsdale.

PHOTOGRAPHS - Anyone who attends this show automatically grants AHAA permission to publish photos taken by AHAA photographers and/or staff in which they and/or their horses appear. No written release is required for AHAA to publish these photos in promotional material.

PRIZE MONEY – No Prize money will be paid out.

PROTEST - A protest must be filed as set forth in the USEF Rules.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR - Refer to current USEF Rule Book.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES - The Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or cancel any entries of any exhibitor as stated in the current USEF Rule Book.

REFUNDS - UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY FEES, STALL AND/OR TACK ROOM CHARGES BE REFUNDED TO THE EXHIBITOR. If payments are made with a credit or debit card the convenience fee of 4% will be deducted from any refunded overpayments. Noncompliance of rules will not be eligible for any refunds.

RETURNED CHECKS - All returned checks will be assessed a \$50.00 charge. Additionally, all declined & invalid credit cards provided will be assessed a \$50.00 charge per transaction (attempted). All fees must be paid in full by cash, cashier's check or money order before packets will be released in the Horse Show Office. The Show Management reserves the right not to accept checks from persons that have provided returned checks previously.

RV SPACE - Spaces are available on the show grounds. Please make your reservations directly with WestWorld. Contact WestWorld at (480) 312-6810.

SAFESPORT - All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

SALE HORSES: Every sale horse will have a special large colored dot on the exhibitor's number to indicate that the horse is for sale.

SCHEDULE - Show Management reserves the right to change the dates and/or the location of the show or to cancel the show altogether. In the event of a cancellation, all entry fees and stall fees will be refunded (office fees are non-refundable). Neither the Show Management nor the Arabian Horse Association of Arizona, shall have any liability to any exhibitor, owner, handler or other person, firm or corporation by reason of any change or cancellation of the show, except for the return of fees as aforesaid.

SECURITY - Exhibitors are advised that it is their responsibility to secure all their valuables while on the show grounds. AHAA will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. No security will be provided by the show.

SHARPS CONTAINERS – Trainers, owners, exhibitors or agents are advised that improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments will result in fines of \$100 per occurrence.

SHOEING REGULATIONS - Refer to current USEF Rule Book.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS - The Horse Show Office will be open Wednesday, November 12th from 1pm – 5pm and 10am – 5pm on Thursday, November 13th. During the show the office will be open one hour prior to the start of classes and will close 30 minutes following the last class of the day.

STATE ENTRY - Tax & Requirements - If any tax is levied, it is the responsibility of the exhibitor and not the show. At the border of Arizona, you will need a HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND COGGINS on your horse(s) including complete description of horse, complete home address and complete address of the show. The certificate must also state that the horse is coming to the show and must give location of return trip. This certificate must be dated within 30 days of the show.

STALLS - All stalls will contain stall doors. Fee for box stalls is \$100.00, NO PRORATION. NO STRAW IS ALLOWED. Stalls will be available for move-in at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 12th, and must be vacated on Monday, November 17th by 6:00 am. No early arrivals.

STALL DAMAGE - Stalls must be vacated in their original condition. STALLS MAY NOT BE STRUCTURALLY ALTERED IN ANY WAY. DO NOT PUT NAILS INTO STALL WALLS. Exhibitors will be financially responsible for damage to their stalls and/or labor costs for removing materials used for stall decorative purposes. Damage, labor and replacement costs will be billed to exhibitor at the current WestWorld fee schedule. NO SMOKING IN THE BARN AREA.

STABLING RULES - Each horse must be assigned a separate stall and must be entered in the show. Only manure must be placed in areas designated, violators caught placing anything other than manure and shavings in designated areas will be fined according USEF rules. **ALL SHAVINGS MUST BE PURCHASED FROM THE ON-SITE APPROVED VENDOR. Violators are subject to a fine and/or removal from the grounds.** Horses must be placed in stalls assigned and no changes will be permitted except by the express consent of the Barn Manager. Decorations to the front of stalls cannot extend more than 6'. By order of the Fire Marshal, all aisle ways between stalls must remain open. All materials used for decorative purposes must be treated with flame-proofing and approved by the Fire Department. The use of electric, open flame or space heaters is prohibited. If you Overload the electric circuit with extra lighting and blow out circuit breakers, you will be billed for the labor to repair or reset the circuit breakers. Cooking or any heat/flame or food preparation is not allowed in the stall area. AUTHORIZED ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES FOR GROOMING PURPOSES MAY BE USED IN DESIGNATED BARN AREAS ONLY. NO UNAUTHORIZED ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES MAY BE USED, OR IF USED, THE APPLIANCES WILL BE CONFISCATED. THE ELECTRICAL SYSTEM MAY NOT BE ALTERED OR TAMPERED WITH UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

USEF MEMBERSHIP -

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

VETERINARIAN - An official Show Veterinarian will be on call from the start of the first class of the day to the end of the last class each day. Veterinarian information will be posted and available in the Show Office.

VETERINARIAN INSPECTION - All horses are subject to a physical inspection, free of charge, by the Show Veterinarians as a safeguard against communicable diseases. AHAA also reserves the right to request a postmortem examination by the Show Veterinarians, free of charge, on any horse which dies on the show grounds.

VIDEO TAPE RELEASE - Signature of the Entry Form constitutes a release of your rights to any remuneration derived from the sale or broadcast of video tapes by the Arabian Horse Association of Arizona.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES – After the close of entries horses may be scratched from the show at the owners/trainer's direction. Under NO circumstances will any fees or stall or tack room charges be refunded to the exhibitor.

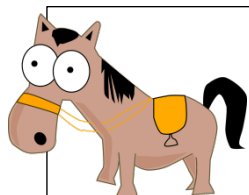

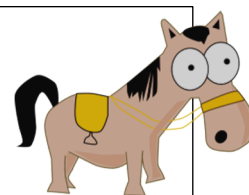

Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

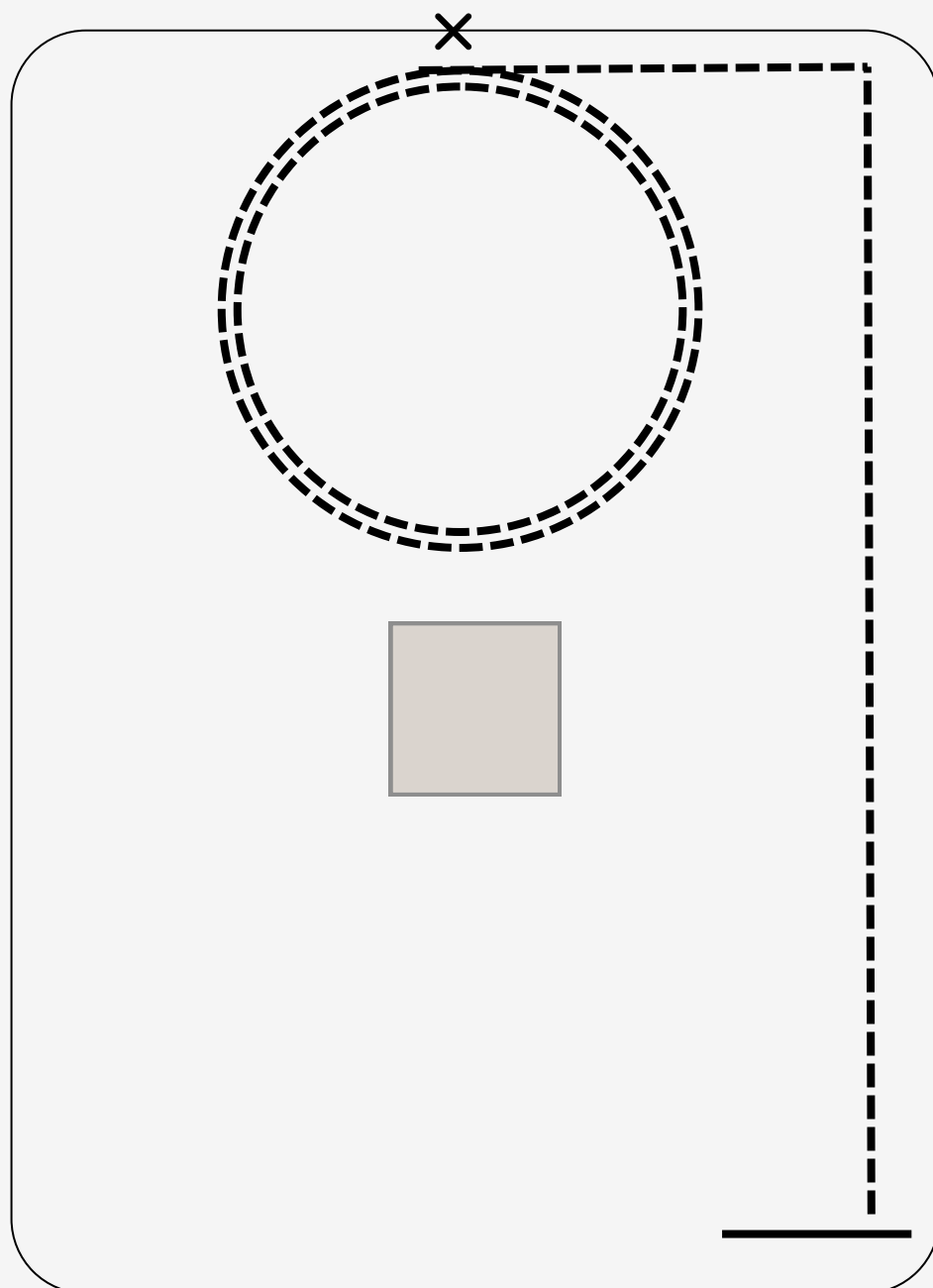
WALK/TROT PATTERN



Walk-Trot Pattern classes will consist of pattern work only, with no rail work included.
(Western riders will walk and jog).

There are no age divisions in this class. Riders will be judged not only on the accuracy of the pattern, but also on their use of correct diagonals and overall form and equitation. Consideration will be given to each rider's individual level of experience. Placings will be awarded in the same manner as any other class. Horses may be shared for more than one rider.

- ① Enter the ring and trot down the rail to your right on the correct diagonal, continuing to the far end of the arena
- ② At the center point, trot a full circle.
- ③ Halt.
- ④ Reverse.
- ⑤ Trot a circle to the right on the correct diagonal, continuing around to the end of the rail.
- ⑥ Halt.
- ⑦ Exit the ring at a walk.



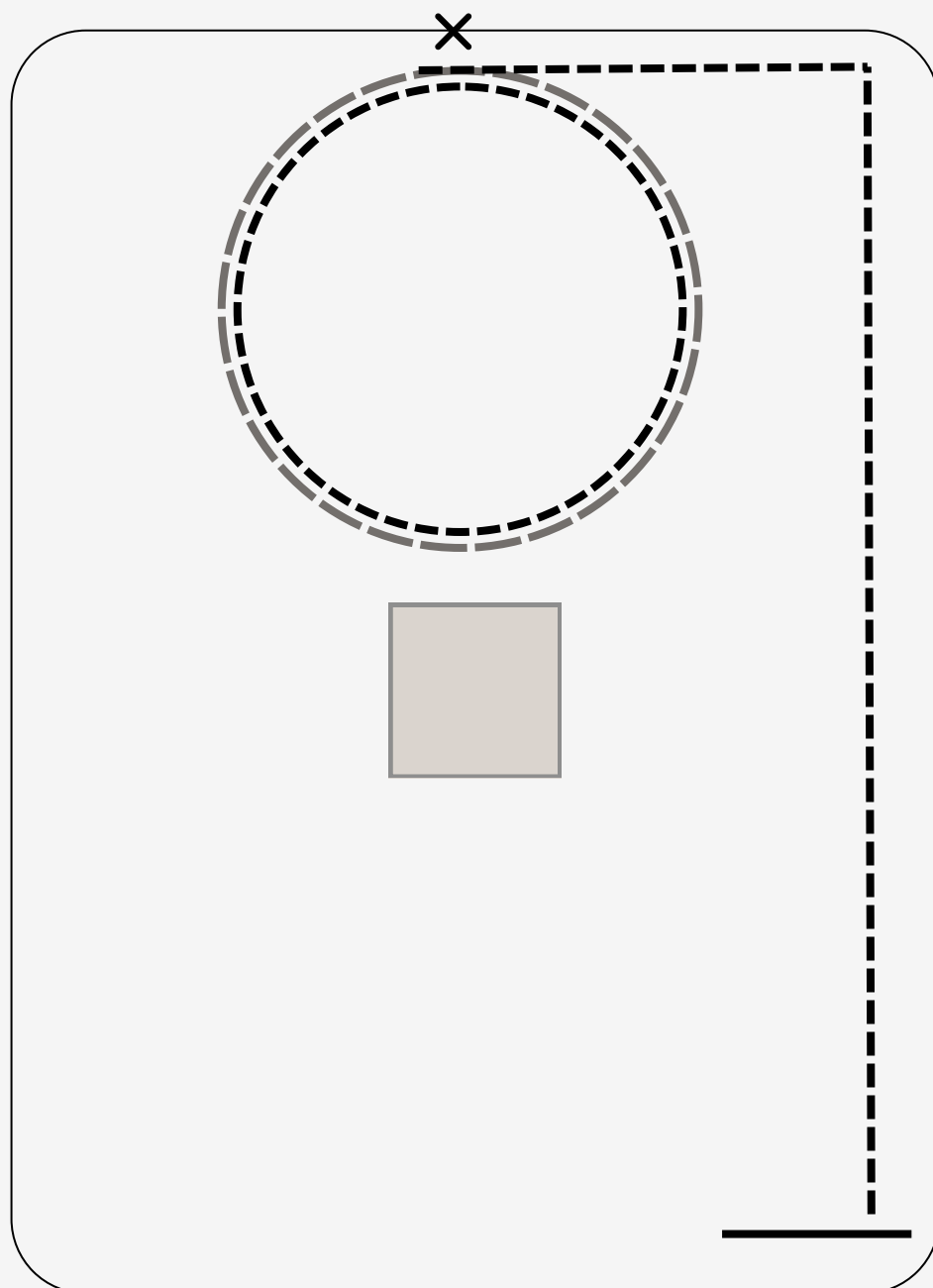
WALK/TROT/CANTER PATTERN



Walk-Trot-Canter Pattern classes will consist of pattern work only, with no rail work included.
(Western riders will walk, jog, and lope).

There are no age divisions in this class. Riders will be judged not only on the accuracy of the pattern, but also on their use of correct diagonals and leads and overall form and equitation. Consideration will be given to each rider's individual level of experience. Placings will be awarded in the same manner as any other class. Horses may be shared for more than one rider.

- ① Enter the ring and trot down the rail to your right on the correct diagonal, continuing to the far end of the arena, **Halt**
- ② At the center point, canter a circle to the left on the correct lead. **Halt**
- ③ **Reverse.**
- ④ Trot a circle to the right on the correct Diagonal, continue trotting around to the end of the rail
- ⑤ Exit the ring at a walk.



RULES & GUIDELINES



Exhibitor Guidelines

- Exhibitor entries are limited to riders currently enrolled in a lesson program.
- Riders who have competed in regular performance classes, or shown in a suit/coat, are no longer eligible for Academy classes.
- Riders who have had a 10-year absence from performance showing are eligible to return to Academy competition in Walk/Trot/Canter.
- A rider who has shown and been judged in Walk/Trot/Canter classes may not return to Walk/Trot classes.
- A rider who has shown and been judged in Walk/Trot classes may not return to Lead Line.
- Riders may not compete in any performance division at the same show, except for driving or in-hand classes.
- Rider age is determined as of January 1 of the current year.

Protective Headgear

- All riders are strongly encouraged to wear protective headgear that meets or exceeds ASTM standards.
- Riders under the age of 17 are required to wear helmets.
- Adult riders are strongly encouraged to wear helmets.

Attire

- Clothing should be appropriate for the style of riding or driving.
- Acceptable attire includes jodhpurs, breeches, dark pants, a long-sleeve collared shirt, tie, gloves, and vest.
- Rider's hair must be neatly secured in a bun or braid so as not to obstruct the exhibitor number.
- Riding suits and jackets are not permitted.
- Chaps and western hats are not permitted.
- Roweled spurs are not permitted.

RULES & GUIDELINES



The Horse

- Horses must be regularly used in a lesson program.
- Horses may be owned or leased, provided they are actively used as lesson or school horses for multiple riders.
- Horses should be plain shod. (Exceptions may be made for corrective shoeing; one pad and/or wedge is allowed for the horse's comfort.)
- Hoof blacking is optional; ribbon braiding is not permitted.
- School horses may cross-enter into regular performance classes at the same event.
- Any breed of horse or pony is eligible, with full mane and tail.

Tack

- Horses must be tacked with a saddle appropriate for the style of riding being judged.
- Acceptable bridles include full or Pelham bridles, or a snaffle bridle with martingale.
- Horses should be tacked as if giving a lesson. Snaffle bridles with martingales are encouraged for young riders; full bridles are also acceptable.
- Any leverage bit rein placed through a martingale is prohibited. (Exception upon approval) Please speak with an AAC Board Member
- Prohibited tack includes overchecks, and double bridle reins through martingales in under-saddle classes.

Judging

- The horse is NOT to be judged.
- Exhibitors are judged on their ability to effectively control and present the horse to its best advantage.
- Horsemanship/Showmanship classes: Judged on the rider's performance ability, including correct use of the ring, leads, and diagonals.
- Equitation classes: Judged on the rider's equitation basics, correct leads and diagonals, and the overall impression of effective, easy control.
- Horses will not be asked to back, perform an extended trot, or hand gallop.
- Headers are permitted in the line-up; towels and whips are not allowed.
- Horses must exit and reenter the arena for each class.
