Location: San Esteban del Toral, Bierzo Alto (Bembibre)

Soil: Ferric clay with stones and granitic sand

Vintage: 2024

Variety: Godello

Aging: 10 months in 500-liter French oak barrels

Alcohol: 13%

Production: 4,389 bottles

Located in the village of San Esteban del Toral, we selected this vineyard for its Atlantic character. We were looking for a late-season area with slow ripening where we could obtain a very fresh wine with aging potential.

This is a 25-year-old organic vineyard, at an altitude of 720 meters, which allows us to play with minerality, freshness, and concentration.

Tasting Notes: Imalia Godello is fresh and elegant on the nose, with subtle notes of white flowers, blending with light citrus notes and mineral nuances. Balanced tension on the palate, with a pleasant enveloping finish and a long finish.
