



3 PARCELAS

"A blend of three carefully selected vineyards. A symbiosis that conveys a unique complexity."

Sites: El Castro (Cacabelos), San Salvador (Torullón), El Vallinón (Orbanajo)

Soils: El Castro (clay-loam rich in limestone), San Salvador (sandy-loam rich in slate), El Vallinón (clay-loam with abundant slate)

Vintage: 2022

Variety: Mencía

Aging: 12 months of aging in 500l French oak barrels

Alcohol: 13.5%

Production: 6148 bottles

Imalia 3 Parcelas is carefully crafted with grapes from century-old vines, cultivated in three vineyards in different areas. A symbiosis develops between them that gives the wine a unique complexity. The three plots are located on steep slopes, and each contributes distinctive characteristics: fluidity, strength, and character. We decided to vinify each one separately and explored various blends until we achieved the desired result.

Tasting notes: the 2022 vintage shows greater concentration than 2021, while maintaining a marked sense of freshness. On the nose, aromas of red berries stand out, complemented by balsamic notes of cardamom and eucalyptus. On the palate, it is subtly tense, with well-defined persistence and a pleasant finish that echoes the initial aromatic impressions.
