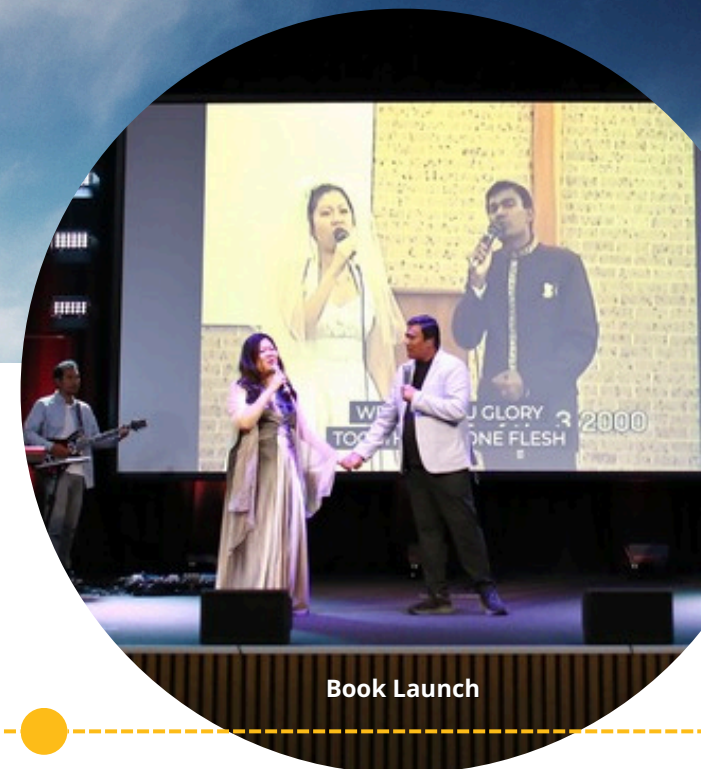
## MARCH

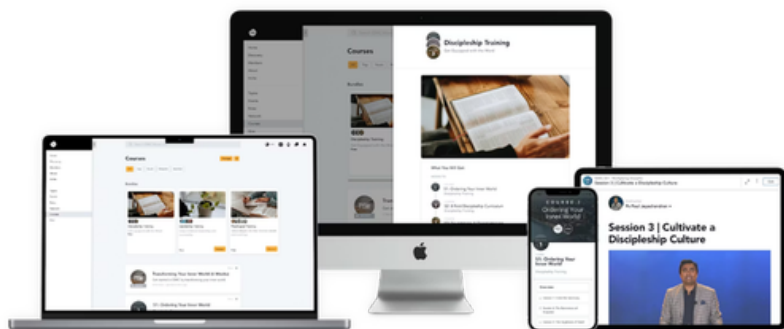


# BIBLE College
