Farwest Insulation Contracting is committed to safety excellence. The basic components of our Safety Program include:

The Safety Program maintains the full support of Senior Management, including the personal overview of the President and Corporate Safety Committee.

Safety policy is communicated through:

- tail-gate job meetings;

- annual branch safety award dinners;
- and safety-tip payroll envelope stuffers.

Farwest Insulation Contracting fully complies with the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard, 29CFR 1910.1200 and 1926.59 regarding warning notices, UN Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (GHS) and required training.



Our low incident rate places our company in the top 25% of all Specialty Trade Contractors as reported by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics.

MEDICAL

All field employees working with hazardous materials are given a comprehensive physical examination upon hire and are then examined on a yearly basis. A chest X-Ray is also taken according to work experience and age.

Drug and Alcohol Abuse Program

To the extent allowable by law, Farwest Insulation Contracting maintains a Substance Abuse Policy consistent with our customers' needs. This can include pre-employment/pre-access, post incident and random drug and alcohol screening.



TRAINING

Safety begins with proper education. Every employee is trained to perform their duties in a manner which will protect himself and those around him, to recognize job hazards, and to be proactive in improving jobsite safety conditions. A work-safe attitude is prevalent throughout the organization.

Quarterly Safety Meeting

The Company holds quarterly safety meetings, which are attended by foremen, leadmen, and management personnel.

Safety Communication

All personnel are required to have a Basic English language skill, which ensures their understanding of signs and warnings on the jobsite.



CPR/First Aid/OSHA 30

Foremen are trained in OSHA 30, CPR and First Aid. Refresher classes are given as required to maintain certification.

Hazardous Communication Program

Farwest personnel are provided with information related to hazardous materials, including how to read and interpret the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling (GHS), where to find information on hazardous materials, and how to read and interpret warning labels. A pre-employment interview and test is given to new employees for speaking and understanding the English language.

Refinery Safety Overview

Farwest personnel working in refineries are given a 20-hour class and annual refresher covering refinery operations, hazards, and safety concerns.

Mine Safety Health Administration (MSHA)

Farwest personnel working in the mining industry receive new miner and/or annual refresher training consistent with the requirements of 30CFR Part 48.

Tailgate Safety Meetings

All projects have weekly tailgate safety meetings, conducted by the cognizant Farwest supervisor and attended by all workers on the jobsite. These meetings cover a set agenda of important safety items and site-specific information, and provide a time for questions and answers related to worker concerns.

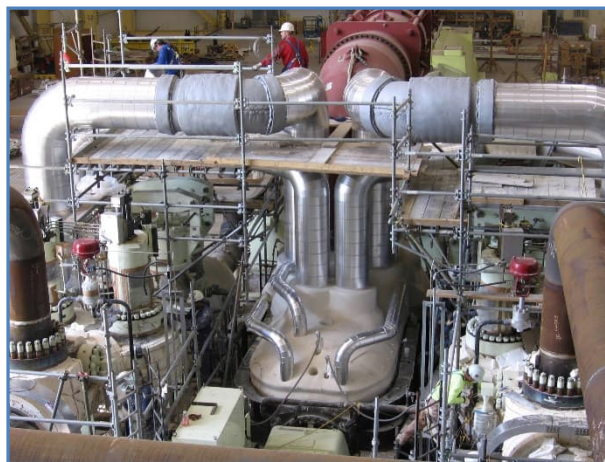

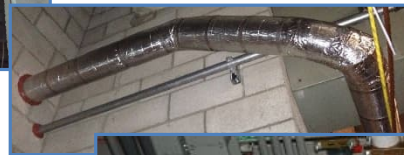

Openings and joints in fire-rated wall, floor, or ceiling assemblies compromise the fire-resistance ratings of those assemblies. Firestop is a passive fire protection system that, when properly installed, will restore the wall, floor, or ceiling assembly to the original fire-rated integrity compromised by the penetration.

Farwest is an FM approved firestop application contractor.

Farwest installs products utilizing experienced personnel that maintain a strong focus on quality throughout all stages of the project. All Farwest firestop installers are trained and qualified by our manufacture's representatives. Farwest also provides continuous internal training to ensure all tested systems are properly installed according to approved design specifications.

In addition to training our personnel on system use in order to install fire protection, we coordinate with our customers before construction to ensure all of the design criteria of the firestop systems are maintained. This pre-coordination includes verifying construction types, types of penetrating items, and proper annular space criteria are maintained as per the construction documents.
