

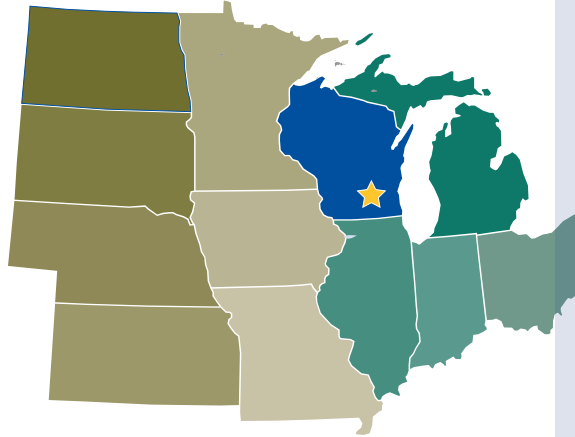

WAUKESHA IS KNOWN FOR...

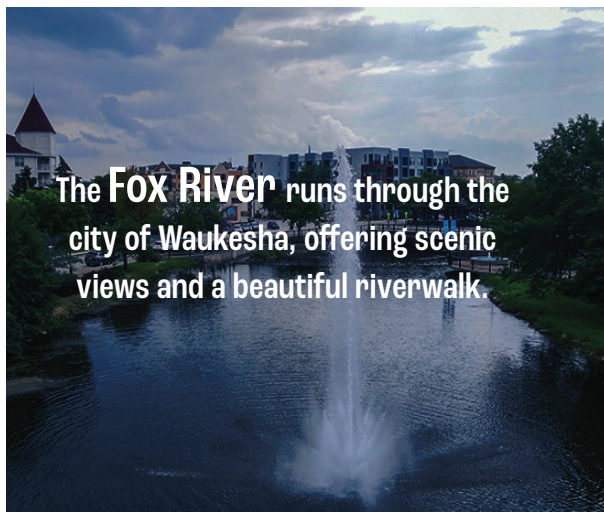
The **seventh-largest city** in Wisconsin.
