## About this Plan

This booklet contains the last of four parts of First Methodist Church's 2025 Bible reading plan. From September 1 through the end of the year, use this plan to explore Paul's letters — and, if you'd like, the book of Malachi. There is one chapter to read each day with no readings on Sundays, allowing time for rest or catching up.

As you go through this plan, we also encourage you to spend time memorizing Scripture.

For each day listed, the plan has two sections: "To Read," containing the Scripture chapter for the day, and "To Memorize," which indicates a Scripture passage to work on committing to memory. The Scripture passages are at the bottom of the last page.

## **Tips for Effective Bible Study**

- Before anything, pray! Ask God to give you insight into His Word.
- Choose a location to study in which you'll be free from distractions.
- Choose a consistent time to read, and one that works with your schedule and habits. If you're not a morning person, for example, it may not be wise to commit to doing your reading at 6:00 in the morning, but 8:00 at night may be an ideal time.
- If possible, set your phone to silent, turn it off, or do not take it into your study area during your reading time.
- Use a journal to record insights, questions, and to write down prayers.
- You may want to keep a Bible dictionary or commentary nearby for questions about the context or meaning of what you're reading, or use a study Bible. The IVP Bible Background Commentary and the NIV Cultural Backgrounds Study Bible are great resources. There are also commentaries available in the Canyon campus' library, just across from the sanctuary. A church staff member can assist you with finding additional materials.
- Read slowly and take time to absorb the Text. If something seems confusing, take the time to pray about it, research it, or discuss it with your GrowGroup.
