Hours/Week & Pay: 5 hours/Sunday (7:30am-12:30pm), \$20 an hour

Responsibilities:

- Work collaboratively with the Worship Producer and worship teams across Traditional and Contemporary services.
- Operate sound, lighting, video, and livestream equipment, including:
 - Front of house, livestream and monitor mixing
 - Camera and livestream operation
 - ProPresenter operation
 - Lighting operation
- Assist with occasional worship nights, concerts and rehearsals
- Provide technical support for occasional funerals, weddings, and other functions if the Worship Producer is unavailable.
- Assist with set-up and preparation for worship services, including:
 - Microphone placement
 - Battery changing/charging
 - Sound checks (with Worship Producer)
 - Setting up livestream
 - Stage set up
- Continue developing technical skills in all areas to ensure the ability to run services independently when necessary
