Academic Year 2026

Kitasato University provides 9 postgraduate schools. The postgraduate school for Veterinary Sciences is one of them, and located in Towada City, Aomori Prefecture, which is the northernmost prefecture on mainland Japan. The postgraduate school started in 1970 as Master's program in Veterinary Science, and in Animal Sciences. In 1972, the university established a doctoral program. Postgraduate study in Bio-production and Environmental Sciences was established in 1987.

At present, the postgraduate school is composed of a master's program and a doctoral program. The master's program provides postgraduate study in Animal Science and Environmental Bioscience, while the doctoral program provides postgraduate study in Animal Science and Veterinary Medicine.

The school term for the master's program is 2 years, while that for the doctoral program is 3 years for Animal Science and 4 years for Veterinary Medicine. In Japan, the number of foreign postgraduate students has been increasing rapidly. The objective of these programs is to contribute through our postgraduate course to the whole world while positively inviting foreign students.

Must include nationality, etc.; status of residence; period of stay; expiration date of the period of stay; katakana notation of name; history of aliases; residence card/special permanent resident certificate number, etc., or Proof of status of residence (for those residing outside of Japan; a document to confirm status of residence as "Student" or "Pre-college student" according to the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act, or a document to confirm status of residence as "Short-Term Stay").
- (13) Two color identification photos: 4 cm high × 3 cm wide; frontal photo (no hat) taken within three months prior to application; attach the same photos to the application form and name and photo form
- (14) Entrance examination fee: ¥20,000

Payment method: Bank transfer or bring cash to the application counter.

If you pay by bank transfer, submit a copy of the bank transfer statement.

(15) Return envelope: Only for applicants applying by mail; submit an envelope addressed to you, since it will be used to send the entrance examination card (stamp not required).
