NOTICE OF COMPLETE APPLICATION

Dear Todd Monson:

Based upon review of the above Permit Application submitted by NY North Country, LLC (Applicant), the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (Office or ORES) has determined that the application submitted by the Applicant on February 14, 2026, amended on June 25, 2026 and supplemented on July 20 and September 4, 2026, is complete.

This letter constitutes Notice of Complete Application pursuant to 16 NYCRR § 1100-4.1(g).¹ A copy of this notice is being posted on the Office's website through the Department of Public Service Document Matter Management (DMM) system. A copy of this notice will also be served via regular mail upon the chief executive officer of each municipality in which any portion of the proposed facility is located, and any person who has previously expressed in writing an interest in receiving such notification.

In accordance with 16 NYCRR § 1100-8.1(a), the Office, no later than sixty (60) days following the date of this letter, shall publish for public comment on its website (through the Department of Public Service DMM system) a draft siting permit for public comment or a statement of intent to deny the Application. This publication will be accompanied by a notice providing information regarding the public comment period, public comment hearing, and issues determination procedure.

¹ The Permit Application was filed with the Office pursuant to Public Service Law (PSL) Article VIII and its implementing regulations at former 16 NYCRR Chapter XI (Part 1100), which were filed with the Secretary of State and became effective July 17, 2024. Revised PSL Article VIII regulations at 16 NYCRR Chapter XI (Parts 1100, 1101, 1102) were filed with the Secretary of State and became effective March 9, 2026. Pursuant to 16 NYCRR § 1100-16.1 of the revised regulations, they apply to applications received by the Office on or after their effective date. As such, this Notice of Complete Application references the former regulations at 16 NYCRR Chapter XI.
