The Regional Flood Control District (District) will hold a public workshop on **Wednesday, April 22, 2026, from 3:30-5:30 p.m.**, to solicit public comment and input on the Draft Stormwater Management Plan and/or the Draft Stormwater Monitoring Plan. Written or verbal comments will be accepted at the workshop. Written comments will be accepted until **April 30, 2026**.

The Draft Stormwater Management Plan and Draft Stormwater Monitoring Plan were developed as a requirement of the Las Vegas Valley Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. NV0021911 (https://ndep.nv.gov/uploads/water-wpc-permitting-docs/Permit_PermitNumNV0021911_Final_Draft.pdf).

The Draft Stormwater Management Plan includes the following elements:

- Stormwater Management Program Introduction and Overview
- Regional Watershed Based Strategy which includes:
 - Public Outreach and Education
 - MS4 Maintenance Activities
 - Post-construction Program for New Development and Significant Redevelopment
 - Illicit Discharge and Detection
 - Industrial Facility Monitoring and Control
 - Construction Site Best Management Practices (BMP) Program
- Description of Measures to Comply with NPDES Discharge Permit No. NV0021911
- Measurable Goals for Each Measure

The Draft Stormwater Monitoring Plan includes the following elements:

- Introduction
- Sampling Equipment, Storm Event Tracking and Collection Protocol
- Handling and Analysis Protocol
- Evaluation of Characterization Data

Since these elements conform to and satisfy the provisions of the MS4 Permit, and because the District has been working with the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) on revising the elements as necessary, the District has made the preliminary determination that these elements comply with the requirements of the MS4 Permit.
